ANONYMITY

DO YOU KNOW...that TGV, Guatemala City, Guatemala, C.A., is being heard on a frequency of 1220 kc., instead of their listed 1210...Dr. Brinkley's KEA, Villa Acuna, Mexico station has been reinstated by a decision of Mexico's supreme court, and as a consequence will resume broadcasting as soon as repairs are made to the xmtr...due to some technical difficulties WBNY, 1370 kcs., Buffalo, N. Y., has not yet started broadcasting, so watch future tests, that the station has been assigned a frequency check period for the first Monday of each month from 3 to 3:20 A.M. EST...starting March 1, 1936 Chicago (not rest of Illinois) will go on Eastern Standard Time...the wavelength and power shifts of stations on regional channels will not go into effect (if then) until after the November elections, for obvious reasons...there are 56,221,784 radio receivers used in this ole world, with the U.S. having almost half--26,632,981; Great Britain 7,055,464; Germany 6,516,732 and the whole European continent only having 22,897,464...that KALB, 1420 kcs. Alexandria, La. has a frequency check the first Thursday of each month from 2:10 to 2:30 A.M., EST... and WTAL 1310 kcs. Tallahassee, Fla. has a similiar test on the same morning from 2:30 to 2:50 A.M., EST...that KG EK, 1200 kcs. Sterling, Colo., no longer are required to test the first Saturday... that KOOS, Marshfield, Ore. have announced that their December test will be conducted on 1390 kcs...Provo, Utah, will receive a new 100-watter on 1210 kcs., as will Salt Lake City on 1500, owned respectively by the Great Western Broadcasting Association and the Utah Broadcasting Company...WKJC, 1200 kcs. will move to Easton, Penna. and change call letters to WEST...Temple, Texas, will probably get a new station of 100 watts on 1310 kcs., as will Chatanooga, Tenn., on 1200 with 100 watts...KGBU, 900 kcs. Ketchikan, Alaska, will probably have it's power boosted to 1000 watts night, 5000 watts days...KHBC, 1420 kcs., Hilo, Hawaii will start broadcasting on January 1, 1936...WCKY, 1490 kcs., Covington, Ky., is erecting a new 350-foot tower which, it is estimated, will be equivalent to an 80% boost in power...it is likely (according to plans being drawn up at this time) that an international station will be built at St. Stephen, N.B., Canada, across the St. Croix River from Calais, Maine...WFLD, 900 kcs., Frederick, Md., has asked for another 30 day extension, starting November 26...WKZO, 590 kcs., Kalamazoo, Mich., will DX from 2:30 to 3:30 A.M., on November 23...WTHV, 1500 kcs., E. St. Louis, Ill., will DX on December 8, from 1 to 3 A.M., EST?

DID YOU KNOW THAT...VK3ZK, 7300 kcs., 33 Saturn St; Caulfield, S.E.8, Australia, has increased their power to 100 watts (from 25) and broadcasts twice weekly--Sunday from 1:30 to 3 A.M. and Wednesday from 2 to 3 A.M., EST..."Radio Oceanic", a new station on 7100 kcs., located in Tahiti, South Seas, is heard from 11 P.M. to 12, midnight, EST, on Tuesdays and Fridays...CP4, 9120 kcs., LaPaz, Bolivia, S.A., will DX December 1 from 2 to 3 A.M., EST...JVN, Nazaki, Japan, on 10.66 megs., tests Mondays and Fridays from 4 to 5 P.M., with JVP on 7.51 megs. also used. HJalBK, 7074 kcs., Baranquilla, Columbia, S.A. is on the air every Sunday from 3 to 6 P.M., EST, and that the address is Clemente Vassallo, Apartado Postal 580, Baranquilla...each month, starting December 2, HB9B, 14.04 megs., Basle-1, Switzerland, will broadcast programs on the first Monday from 3:10 to 4:15 P.M., EST. Radio Lyon (1393) Another new catch but too much interference to copy. All this week foreigners continue good.

RANDOLPH HUNT, N.P.O. #3, Encinitas, Calif. - XEMZ Coronado Islands (P.O. Box 538 San Diego, Calif.) is back on 820 kcs. from 1210 kcs. they announce as 'The Voice of the Pacific' KDOM Del Monte and Monterey, Calif. rides over everything on 1210 kcs. this is probably the reason for change of frequency of XEMZ. KEMO in Tijuana, (P.O. Box 202 San Diego, Calif. is still on the air, it was reported that this station was destroyed by fire. As of Nov. 14, KFBK 1310 kcs. had not changed to 1490.
