Box # 422 Perth Amboy N.J., stating the date report was sent and if either IRC, Stamps, or Money Order was enclosed, also if any Follow Ups have ever been sent and the date of same. As soon as I get the list of the stations who have ignored DX reports to date I will forward same to the RHC Cadena Azul's Official who in turn assured me that he would put it before certain high Cuban Government Officials for consideration and in the very near Future a degree will be issued in regards to the verification problem of the Cuban Station.

The above was talked over while the WDXA official was in conference with a RHC Cadena official. There is to be some kind of a contest or special programs in the future. I will publish it as soon as any word is received by your editor.
