DICK COOPER-KITTANNING PENN Recent veries include a swell letter from KTOH and letters from WABC-WLS3-KTBS-WLBC; Cards from WHIS-CFOS-CKNX. Heard KAVE on Nov freq check and Canadians CKNB-CKRN-CJIC-CHLN-CKNX and CKCO. CHRC was on 800 kcs in back of CKLW I think. Sorry that I did not have time to dedicate selections to all the boys on WISR program, will take care of them in April when we will have another one, maybe. KIL0 shares time with KFJL in Grand Forks, neither station was deleted. WwPG to take the air this month and also WFIN. KFFA now on.

DEAN LONDON-BINGLING OKLA On 11/11 alarm failed to go off so missed the Canadians all of which have not been heard here; 11/12 No CHRC and I see in the new Radex that they are listed on 800 kcs but I listened for them on 1400. That leaves me with CBF the only Quebec sta logged. Could detect no CKCO on 1340 but some sta was behind & signed off. (CKCO was on as I reported them-Ray) Again I hrd the unknown sta under WHBC's freq check. They were in the clear from 4:55 until WITH signed on at 5 AM. Late veries WMGA-WATW-WBTM-WGAA-KMED-YV5RI-KGMB and CFOS; Reports out to CKRN-CJIC-CHLN-HJAR-2YC-WWNY. Alarm failed on 11/12 so missed all Canadians. Not much time for DX lately. Conditions freakish only certain regions heard at all, some nights. KEVR hrd about 5 min R4; KGBS Q3 R5; WATW tests 4-4:30 AM 1st Wed and want reports. Got WEIM notice OK. (Contest to J. Kalbach 1195 Wehrle Dr Williamsville N.Y. Have them in by December 2nd for next listing.)

LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N Y Veries in from CFOS card and letter from KNET 11/14 Tried FCC checks but nothing new; 11/16 WBLJ on all morning with Dixie Dancing Party fighting it out with WITH. WRAL also on all AM over riding WEDC. Said they would be on every morning for a week. WMIN also on all night. 11/17 WISR hrd R6-7 with DX program starring that great radio personality Richard H. Cooper. Fine work Dick. DX poor lately.

MEL OLIVER-HOUSTON TEXAS Veries received here this week are KAVE-KOCY-KRLD-KOB-KABC-WGAA-WGIL & KFDM. KRLD stamped Verified across my report initialed it and returned it to me. (Me also Mel-kay) 11/15 Caught KFFA first test program; QTH 215 York St., Helena, Arkansas. WISR just barely heard, but could not read. My receiver just couldnt make it. November Radex received Monday and I was late in subscribing. Now I'm listening for KEAW (XELAW) to get one of his cards. (Note abt our bulletin 1st pg.)

STEVE MANN-HANOVER N H Veries in from Radio Lyon & HJAR. Radio Lyon out 10 months pleased me plenty--my first European BCB verie. HJAR was very pleased with results of special, is sending me number of reporters etc shortly. Only report sent out is to WHYN. Latins continue strong in eves Station on 720 behind WGN pretty definitely believed to be 25 kw PRA8, Recife, Pernambuco, Brasil. Signs off between 9:30-10PM. Not logged as yet Daytime reception here usually lousy but hrd WJJD at 3:30 PM one day.

AL BARTHOLOMEW-BRADFORD N Y wed AM caught what I am sure was KTPN Tacoma test on 1430 4:30-5:16 and after; sig poor & badly distorted although calif sta were good, ubderstood ann to sat KTPN, cant imagine who else on that freq. KSAN & KORE battling on 1450; WK20 caught on DX test. Swell verie card from CFOS. WIS6 caught but reception not too good here.

J WARREN ROUTZAHN-YORK PA Since last report I logged, WvNY-WRRN-WBOC-WISR & KMYR. Veries in from WGAA-WLAG-WBOC-KERN-KWAT-CFOS & KSD. Nov 5 WSAU R8 test at 3:25; WGAC-R9 test at 3:40 right thru WEDC. 11/9 WCOP-R9 test 4:00; WvNY-R9 for another fine NRC DX program. 11/7 WGTC-R8-2:55 test; WEDC signed for KWAT at 3 with National Emblem, mentioned it was our club theme. They sure must like the NRC. KWAT was R6 on test. WRRN-R8 on test. WBOC-R8-3:45-4 test; 11/11 Couldnt hear CKUA tho. KMJ seemed clear; CKNB used 1240 kc; CJIC on, both about R8; CKRN-R6 and fading at times, KWOC test at 3:55; CHLN-R8 at 4 on DX; 11/12 had all-nighter trouble and they covered up needed stations, CKNX-R8, CKCO-R9 on DX, CFRC was not hrd here. 11/13 KFJM using old call yet, hoped they would use KILO on freq check, KSD was on test 5-6; 11/17 WISR strong on NRC DX, Dick Cooper taking over, WRAL on every night this week they announced. 11/18 KHOD-R7-3-3:30 their reg 3rd Tues test, WCOP testing, KMYR signed 4 AM just after WEXL went off.

KTBI is on daily until 3:30 AM EST and is anxious for reports, they might be heard out this way during the FCC weeks when 1490 is sometimes open during their last half hour. CKCO 4-4:30 Q5 R9; WTAW on 1150 4:40-4:55 FCC; KRKD signs off for that test. 11/13 KPLC (2nd rpt) on 1490 4:05-4:20; KGCU (wish it were KGBU) 1270 4:40-4:55; KFJZ signs off for this ck; 11/14 KWJB and WNLC; 11/16 WGNV rpted 9:44-10 AM on 1220 Q5 R9; WGNV on 1220 for several months. WISR special on 11/17 Q5 R9 with Dick Cooper dedicating selections, another good daytime local; Veries received are cards WMPC-CFOS-CKNX; Letters KRLD verie, rpt sent was stamped verified.

BOB DROWN-GOSHEN IND I made a little discovery--XEFO is using 1107 kcs instead of 1110 kcs. At first I thought it was HJCB, The announcement was XEFO y XEDZ Radio Cadena Nacional, Mexico City. THE FOLLOWING LETTER FROM BILL STONE

Today, I received the carton of Phillip Morris cigarettes sent to me by the Officers & Members of the National Radio Club, and for which I thank all those concerned from the bottom of my heart. This present may seem a small thing to you people, to us who smoke, its life blood, I will now show you what I mean by this statement.

Through enemy action in the middle of August, I lost four consignments of cigarettes, this is no secret, we all have been notified by daily orders as well as the British Press, more than two weeks ago. This loss came for me at the wrong time, the result I was forced to buy English cigarettes.

English cigarettes, in your money cost thirty-six cents for a package of twenty, a man like myself who smokes thirty cigarettes per day, the cost would be fifty-four cents. This is a daily figure, multiply this by seven and the cost is \$3.78. A private draws two pounds over here every 2 wks in our money \$8.94, a lad not getting any money through punishment only draws \$2.24; over a two week period buying English cigarettes a soldier would use \$7.56 of his semi-monthly pay leaving him \$1.38. From supper to breakfast is a period of 15 hours, most soldiers spend at least \$1.22 in the canteens over here for eats say before bedtime every 2 weeks, 10 shillings or \$2.24. By this itemizing I am pointing out to you just how much we rely on the cigarettes we get from home, and friends, good friends like you people who donated this carton of cigarettes. The supplies we get from home go to help a soldier having some money in his pocket, or none at all and in most cases this is put in clean entertainment such as shows or the odd glass of beer.

Smoking enjoyment when I tell you there is absolutely no comparison in English cigarettes, with that of America or Canada, I mean it.
