DAVE THOMAS-PROCTORVILLE O. Perhaps after the Poem I'd better give the NRC members a correct idea on Beverage Waves. The FCC engineer's helped me with mine. B.W. is a full wave aerial, matched and balanced by resistors, for both in and out phrase reception. Reflection transformers and other things, and complete explanation would require about 15 pages. The smallest wave must not be under 1000 ft (one straight line) Best results is 1800 ft between insulators. (Lead in can be up to 1/2 mile in length and still not effect directivity of wave) Each wave costs \$75.00 complete. Uni-directional wave will receive only within 30 degrees of desired direction--other 330 degrees are nil to signals. For full 360 degree coverage takes 12 waves, or can use bi-directional waves and get 60 degree coverage and 6 waves will equal 12 single ones. I use single wire bi-directional for it is heck to have to go out and change reflector in middle of night if you want to hear 2 stations in opposite directions (1/2 mile to end of aerial) I've spent about \$3000. already in Listening Post, includes farm, buildings and all, and cannot just now afford to erect the 2&3 wire control system (as must be manufactured special and its cost out of the question at this time. Here is an idea as to size of aerials (waves) On long ones it takes 2-3 minutes drive in a car to end of aerials (over dirt ground) when I buy aerial wire I have to order direct from the mills as they run it into spools (100 lbs to 500 lbs) unbroken

DAVE THOMAS-Cont lengths. So not to use splices on any wires. Best grade solid Copperweld wire is used, size 12. Solid copper will not work as it will break under its own weight and pull. Cant stand it. Cost of wire at mills is \$19.50 f.o.b. per hundred lbs so you can figure out what a set of Waves runs into. After sever electrical storm, resistors and at times transformer must be replaced as direct hits from lighting is often, and special care must be made to handle static electricity on these miles of sky wire. Only have two Waves up at present, for storm broke several and cannot get them up now until spring. The reflectin transformers are hardest to replace-may not get any of them now until after war (due to shortage of copper) Must have B.W. freq from everything-whenver it is put up must have 1/3 mile straight strip free of all obstacles. You cant have one in town. B.Waves is no good for S.W. aerial, aerials are on 50 acres. (Thanks a lot for your wonderful information on Beverage Waves-the boys certainly have had a good time kidding about them-Ray)
