LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N Y Well another short report. Again no DX done, but got a nice letter or rather diploma verie from WKAQ, although it got ripped a little in transit, I'll not complain about that, with all the ships getting sunk in the Atlantic. WIAC, San Juan wrote air-mail advising they will dedicate a program to the NRC on April 12th Sunday from 2 to 3 AM EWT. They test the 2nd Sunday every month at that time. This will probably be our last DX this season. They will have competition from WILL the first half hour as they too test then from 2-2:30 AM EWT. KBWD must have quite a staff, 3 different verie signers were sent in for Jack Quintrell. Take your pick Jack. When WCNW goes to 1190 kcs they will become WLIB, "The Voice Of Liberty". WKNY had gotten 18 reports by 3/26 & are willing to repeat sometime. CKVD were nappy over the reports they received from Wisconsin. (They cancelled your card on report side again)

BOB BOTZUM-READING PA. New veries received, WIAC-KGBS-KPRO. my 2nd report to WICA was verified by Airmail. C.R.A.-P.O. Box 848 and signed by Felix Muniz, freq sked 2nd Sun 2-3 AM EWT. KGBS now has freq ck 4th Mon 3:30-3:45 AM EWT. according to verie. KPRO finally verified my Dec 1st report with a picture card showing view of station. It was sent to Reading Montana by mistake. Also verie, letter from WMDR on 610 kcs. They sign on at 6:30 AM EWT and have been on the air since Oct 3rd, signed by Leslie F Smith, manager. (Bob, Al's KEYR-WMYR are KEVR-WMVA.-Ray)

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N Y Very little time here for DX, so no reports lately. with the start of March I decided to have another fling at DX again, maybe the FCC's ban on new stations encouraged my fostered hope of hearing every USA broadcaster, a goal that I once came within 5 stations of reaching. I've lost count of how many I lack now. Anyway a little morning tuning added the following, 2/17 CKVD on DX, R7 here, stopped even WITH. 2/28 KFUN on reg ck, hrd easily thru the 1230 GRM. 3/4 WASK testing R8. 3/5 WCRS on check and KBUR on most of morning with arsenal explosion reports, came thru the WJBK mess a little at times. 3/7 WHLN on check; 3/11 WOSH on check, WOSH evidently on 2-2:30 as hrd 2:20-2:30 here, R7 and about equal to WJBK. CKVD DXing on 3/10 easy, but not as good as on 2/17, was asking for reports and greeted the NRC. Pulled the old stunt of shutting off alarm in sleep on WKNY and after wanting them for years. Just a note from Norm Maguire, who says he is having SW reports to South American stations returned by the US censors. Norm also states that the African services of the European stations seem to be the best heard in New Mexico. Here's latest official listing of the the BBC North American transmissions, 6110 kcs GSL 10 PM-12:45 AM; 9580 kcs GSC 5:15 PM-12:45 AM; 11750 kcs GSD 5:15 PM-9:45 PM. This from BBC.

Roger Legge gives the following as the schedule of the Russian broadcasters as received from Kuibyshev; 6950 kcs 1-4 PM; 7130 kcs 12:15-1 AM; 7200 kcs 2-5 PM (English at 4 PM); 8050 kcs 11 AM-6:30 PM (English at 4 PM); 10040 kcs 12-12:30 AM; 1-1:30 AM; 7-10:50 AM (English at 1-8:50 and 9:30 AM); 14400 kcs 8:50-9:15 AM in English.

Roger also says this about the USSR stations. The transmitters on 6115-9565-11885 and 15230 kcs are located at Komsomolsk in Siberia. These stations announce as Moscow and the programs originate there, but the transmitters are in Komsomolsk. And to Roger thanks for trying for The Mud Island station.
