JIM WEDEWER-DYERSVILLE IA. Not much BCB DX here lately due to noise, but am in hopes of logging some TPs yet as weak carriers are constantly coming in here in Am. My new 320R Sky Champion works fine but is noisy as old set on BCB. My latest veries are two beautiful cards from CBFY-CBFW a silver map on white with red and blue design and large red "Canada Calling" at top of card. Have the XEFW card now which Norma Maguire said was a prize verie and boy is that a dandy. It shows a senorita posed before the XEFW mike. It came in 2 weeks and was sent on an October 1941 report. Also received verie cards from WJHL-WbNS-CR7BE-HJCA-CBF-WTIC-CFRB. New ones hrd WIZE-KFXJ test at 3am April 4th. Sw conditions were excellent up to April 2nd and then the bottom fell out. Log on BCB is now 178 veries in a year aprox. (Swell work Jim. 178 is a lot of them)

NORM MAGUIRE-ALBUQUERQUE N MEX. I have been very busy for the past few weeks so have very little DX dope but I'll pass it on. Veries in from KRSC-KROW-KFSD. Reports out to KFFA-KTHS-KPAS-KJR. Said that I hadn't heard KPAS, well finally did. However had to pull it thru WBT at that. Cant get WBT out of the way here. Am listening to KJR right at this moment. Have just gotten back from KGG and have turned the receiver on. The usual stations are pouring in but nothing new at all. Get either coast with ease. Now for the news as was gleaned from Broadcaster. WAGA increase from 1 kw to 5kw on 590 kcs. KXEL-Waterloo on 1540 kcs with 50 kw after June 1st. WAAT-Jersey City applied for change of location to Newark. WGBG-Greensboro NC on 980-1kw; New CP to a station in Elkins Va. The Kodiak Alaska station grant has been shelved for the present due to war conditions. XELO is trying to move to Juarez and use 800 kc with 150 kw. Boy will that be terrible if it does, being so close here. The DX season is about over for another year, lets hope conditions are improved all around when the next season rolls around. Thanks to the very usefull test schedule you listed recently. I hope to add a few more this month. (Hope you are feeling OK again)

GRANT DATSON-WESTFIELD N.Y. well I sent twice as many reports as veries received. I havent deserted the BCB for SW either. Reports were sent to YV5RM-6.150; HRP1-6.375; Radio Centre Moscow-15.230; COCA-9.270; PJCI on 9.0950; HER4-9535; HIT-6.630 and HI9T on 6.174; Aslo WASN-1470 on 3/25 from 5:09-5:30am Q5 R9; KFUN-1230 freq ck on 28th 3:15-3:30am Q3-4 R7; WHUB-1400 on 4/1 3:00-3:15am Q4 R9 and to CHEX-1430 on 4/3-7:44 to 8Pm Q4 R9; Veries received, card yes from KMJ for a report of 12/25/40, also KFUN; letters from Radio Brazzaville-WHUB-WBAN with BKKO stamp-HI30 a letter and card which is a beauty. BOB BOTZUM-READING PA. DX at a stand still here. Have been laid up with the Flu the past 10 days and still too weak to roll out at 2AM. Only 2 new veries received lately, both letters. WTTM-XELA. I sent my report to XELA in Spanish on a post card and was surprised to receive a letter back in a weeks time verifying said report. Their QRA is "Senor Jose Saurez Garride"- Jefe del Dpto de Control y Publicidad - Apartado 1087 - Mexico City, D.F. (well another one down, well we hope you too feel a lot better by now)

ED NYMAN-HORNELL N.Y. Back again with another report (no Ed always very glad to get them) well anyway I got actually 7 veries in the past two weeks, namely letters from KFYR for rpt of 12/14/41 but no mention of my 3/12 rpt-WJAX-WMFR-KFFA and cards from WNAO-WISH-WSOY. 3/17 WNAO on reg sked; 3/18 WISH freq ck; 3/19 KFFA on test; 3/23 WINN freq ck; 3/24 WPAX freq ck; 3/25 WNOE reg sked, 3/26 WWPB on test also KFPY on reg sked R9. 3/27 WGTm freq ck; 3/28 WBBM reg sked also KFUN on check who said they would be on next month (April 25th) 4th Saturday from 3:15-3:30 Am EWT. 3/30 hrd WEMD on reg sked. Here is what I imagine all of you SW DXers and some of our BCB DXers have been waiting for. Your editor at Club HQ wrote to the Director of Censorship in Washington and here is their reply word for word. I also sent a sample report to them in order to give them an idea of what I was talking about; Their reply is; Dear Mr Edge, The copy of report to Radio station YV5RI in Caracas, Venezuela enclosed with your letter of March 28th to the Secretary of War is not objectional. I believe however it would be advisable to Omit the headings "Temperature"- "Barometer" and "Weather" from your report form even though the headings are not filled in. For the information of the members of the National Radio Club I am enclosing a copy of the Rules prepared for the guidance of persons corresponding with foreign countries, they are as follows,

- 1-Postal communication with enemy or enemy occupied countries is illegal and will not be permitted, except;
  - a-Through the agency of the American Red Cross, which will transmit short messages of a personal nature.
  - b-Communications with Prisoners of War.
- 2-In order to make the censorship of International mail as effective and economical as possible, the public is earnestly requested to conform to the following rules in regard to correspondence with persons in foreign countries, other than enemy or enemy occupied countries;
  - a-The name and full address of the sender must be stated both on the outside of the envelope and in the letter itself.
  - b-Correspondence should be in English if possible, the letters should be legible, clear and brief. Avoid use of abbreviations, nicknames, phrases or codes in place of customary reference or descriptions of any person firm, location or other information.
  - c-If English is not used the name of the language should be written in English on the face of the envelope.
  - d-No mention should be made of defense matters, shipping, weather conditions
  - e-Firms employed on munitions or other government work should not mention that fact in writing abroad.
  - f-Firms and individuals, except as indicated in g below should refuse to act as intermediaries or agents for the receipt and transmission of postal correspondence on behalf of persons in foreign countries.
  - g-A member of the Army corresponding with foreign countries will not give the name of his post, camp, or station, but should give as his address the Army Post Office number of his unit in care of Postmaster New York or San Francisco or the address of a friend or relative in the U.S. to whose care a reply can be sent for forwarding.
- 3-Failure to comply with these rules may lead to delay in transmission or to the return of correspondence to the sender. signed, Byron Price.
