LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N Y Veries in from WRBL-KSJB-WJBO (Oct) all N R C specials. Reports to WHAZ-XEFI-KFUN. 10/30 WLBL Stevens Point, Wisc was on with test at 3:15, R9 and then some. 11/2 WHAZ began their DX at 1AM. The listing was my error in interpreting their letter, which said that they would stay on till 2AM for us. They generally sign at midnight, but carried MBS programs until 1AM. They announced at 12:30 AM they would have a DX program from 1-2AM. The program as usual was excellent and they had Vitimized De-hydrated and Homoginized Sanitary Synthetic Snowballs this year, made in Goldberg, Alaska. Best gag was about the football player with State Penn who helped his team beat an Army Camp, proving that the Penn is mightier than the Sword. They gave us a fine publicity and mentioned many times the prize for the furthest report and they read our tips. WBRK was testing and one other on 1340 at 2:05AM WGR testing at 2:10 (only R-6 here) WCAU was on all AM. They seem to replace WIP on Tuesdays. CEG instead of KEAW on 1050 kcs. WSLB off of check at 2:28AM and WCED signed from theirs at 2:48 and somebody signed 1 minute later, also with National Anthem on 1240 kc. I pulled KFUN in testing at 3:09 in the clear on 1450 kc all AM. KSJB reports 17 reports received. 16 from NRC members, 5-Ill; 4-NY; 3-PA; 2-Ohio; 1-Wisc; 1 No Car; 1-No Dak; Mavis Kreis was the non-member on No Dak. WRBL got only 15 reports all from NRC members. NEITHER STATION MENTIONED GETTING ANY THANK YOU CARDS. Dont forget that important detail, will you fellows? If you can try for the programs and dont hear it, or if you cant try for it PLEASE SEND THAT CARD OF THANKS. It means a lot. Dont let the CPC down-We're working hard for you all.

MARSHALL BLANCHARD-BROOKFIELD ILL Not many reports have gone out lately, only WRBL-TGW-WEGO-KFAC. Veries have been received from KSJB-KWFC-WDAK-KALB-WJBO-KGVO-WJBZ-WGBR-WBBZ in the past little while. Could anyone tell me how to log and verify Delaware-Maine or New Hampshire? These are the 3 states I need for 48. Also need Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island. in Canada. Every morning I listen, I am sticking to 650 kc for about 15 minutes in hopes of snagging 1YA. I think I can hear whispers down the channel but it may be only my imagination.. if fact it probably is. Had a visit from Don Watterbarger on the 31st. We compared notes between Calif DXing and that in Ill and then went over to the Zoo. Don is with the Navy V-12 program and will soon be at Great Lakes. ( Try for WHEB on 750 kcs at 4:59 AM EWT or 3:59 AM CWT, I caught them coming on the air thru WSB. This was year ago-Ray.) In the Broadcaster is a DX corner. It says that DX is in general poor but the eastern states come thru well. (NEW-Victoria Etc) but Africa and Europe are disappointing. Also to WBYN for test on 10/24 from 1:14-1:22 AM s-off; WTSP on freq check 10/30 3:45-4:15AM and WLBL on equipment test on 10/30 from 4:28-4:38 s-off. (Looks as if a few of us really were lucky to hear WLBL testing as they are a daytime station and I dont know of any reg test sked they have, seems they were on for quite a while as Lefty Cooper hrd them at 3:15 & I reported them from 2:53-2:30 AM and you until 4:38AM-Ray)

FRED VAN VOORHEES-WHITESTONE N Y DX struck a snag here this past week. Only reports sent were to WINN-CHPS-WOV. The Mid-west then gave up the ghost and is still in the shop. So no DX for a while. New veries from WWDC-KFAM. Still have 16 out. 10/25 CHPS on a test and s-off at 2:55AM and WINN logged on reg test 3-3:15AM; KTTS also tested at 3:15AM. 10/26 WOV logged in daytime; 10/28 WMAN testing at 2:30AM and set going off the air at 2:35. End of present DX. Still no verie on either WJBO program & none from WRBL. Think someone asked about a Spick on 730 kc. I think it is CMBF as I have heard him here evenings.

Got all my bulletins up to Oct 9th and your letter of Oct 2nd. I wrote a few V mail letters since leaving the States which you should have by this time (I have Leo) I enjoy getting the bulletins and also LETTERS. Heard so far from Stone (who knows where I am) Edge-Heilley & Becker, also had a letter from Gail Beyer which was delayed account of me moving. I was pleasantly surprised as things worked out better, only bad things we cant get smoking tobacco enough and all movies are old. Glad to know the club is going along OK. I will write to Routzahn. (Yes Leo Tobacco should reach you by the time this bulletin does,\*Ray.)

JOE LIPPINCOTT-CELO NO CAROLINA I have started to put up an antenna of about 800 ft but so far have not enough support to hold it up in the middle I had a wrie of 150 ft that just changed from NNE to ESE and for 1st time today I got WBIR on 1240, usually get WSOC or WGAC, usually the latter. It is surprising how well WGAC comes in here considering how far it is. I am more convinced that antennas makes a very great difference. At present have 33 veries received this fall and have 31 reports out. I am aiming at 1000 veries total by the end of this season and I do not have so very far to go. At present rate I might get there by the 1st of the year/ Still very little is DX. Did I note you reported to XEFI? (Yes Joe I did and reports to Mex seem to go through Ok-\*ray)(I send either Mex stamps or 5¢ in US coin) Expect to try for WSUI tonight but do not know what time to try 12 to 2 or 2:30 to 3L30. Should be some election returns tonight also. Glad to know when elections take place in any of the states. (Joe it seems that reports get to Mex-Canada-Hawaii-P.R. & Cuba along with the Bahamas but other countries it seems that reports themselves are out and are returned by the censors-nay)

(Prendergast) Also that this monitor has been busy erecting a mast for a double-doublet antenna, the antenna is practically completed, needing only about 75 ft of twisted leadin wire. It is hoped that this new system will add several new stations, now unable to be heard. (Prendergast)
