DX SPECIAL from CKNX

DX SPECIAL from CKNX

This station will be on the air for the National Radio Club from 3:00 to 4:30 AM EWT November 30 1943. It was originally scheduled for Nov 17th but it was too late to get this information around. Here is the set up as to how it will be broadcast. From 3-4 AM Full 1000 watts non directional; From 4-4:45 AM Directional with power concentrated 15' west of North--approximate power of 1400 watts in center of beam. Power South--roughly in line with Buffalo N.Y 250 watts and power in direction of Toronto Canada is 500 watts. From 4:15-4:30 on 100 watts only and then at 4:30 back to 1000 watts non-directional for sign off. Now this station wants reports on the full program so PLEASE get up and tune in and send a real report to Rupert Bedford, CKNX announcer. This station was not asked to DX for us as they are doing this of their own free will. They did broadcast a DX program for the National Radio Club in 1939 and received such good results that they decided to dedicate this program to us and in turn they want reports on this program commenting on the different antennas and power. ORES WILSON-READING PA I think the DX NEWS looks very neat and has plenty in it. This is my first report as a new member. Had some nice letters from Joe Becker and also his QSL card. Have 826 BCB Veries since 1930 & use a GE-6 tube set now. DX occasionally, usually Sunday mornings. Here is what I look for in the DX NEWS. However did use my wife's Zenith to get the very swell show from WHAZ. Up for WSUI but no soap with the Zenith. Did report WSNJ and WBRK on with election returns. Up this morning to get WKNY. A very good program but heard WJBK and another behind them, so may not have hrd by many. Funny thing, DX was terrible. Up at 4, I couldnt hear WITH or WOL. No sign of WEXL either. Just a bum morning here for DX. Enjoyed a grand visit from Lefty Cooper yesterday and we really talked DX as we had a grand DX talk fest about all DX in general, spending the afternoon at it. Ernie told me I was neglecting a gold mine in early and late evening DX. Then to prove it, he showed me on my Midwest that I could log WFEA-WRNL-WBEN-WBNF all between 6-6:30 last evening. I need all those too. We also discovered plenty on during the day that I need. WHBI is on Sundays only, we find. He and I had a little argument over location of WNBC. I claimed it was in Hartford and he in New Britian. I won that one on the 6:30 announcement. Very interesting experiment on 1240 last evening. At one time WSNY was on top, one half hour later WSNJ was the big gun. On 1340 it was interesting too, WALL leads all day, then just at dusk WNBH was tops and later WBR was riding over all the rest. JAPAN-Most consistent Japanese stations are heard on 750 and 800 kc. However, Japanese stations on 875-1015 & 1055 kc have been heard around 6:15AM. Location of these stations is unknown as I have no log showing Jap stations on split frequencies.

CHINA-Chinese station on 900 kc heard every morning after 6AM believed to be XQJB, Shanghai. They feature a program of Oriental music nos.

ROSSIA-Russian station on 880 kc heard nearly every morning and carries the same program and is heard at the same time as the short wave Siberian station on 5930 kc. This leads me to believe that the BCB station is located in Siberia-possibly Khabarovsk.

AUSTRALIA-High frequency "Aussies" come in best and good reception has been had from 2KO-1410; 2LW-1430; 4BH-1380; 3CL-1350; and from 4AK-1220 kc. 3LO in Melbourne on 770 kc and 5KM-810 kc have also been heard after 6:15 AM.

NEW ZEALAND-1YA Auckland on 650 kc and 3YA in Christchurch on 720 kc have been heard with fair signals being the only two New Zealand stations heard this fall.

The only US station I've heard has been WHKY-Hickory, No Carolina on 1290 at 6:43 AM on Oct 22nd. The last 2 days I've been bothered again by power line QRM so am looking forward for another rain to clear up the noise & give me some quiet reception for the coming NRC tests.
