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TIPS and LPO REPORTS

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FRED VAN VOORHEES-WHITESTONE N.Y. Reports sent out since last report have been to WJBO-XEMX-WGRM-WBRK-WLOF-CKCO-WFBR-WBBR-WEGO. Veries in from WPTF WFPA-WHAZ-WPAB, latter passed censor. Still have 28 reports out but hope not lost on any yet. Here's the week, 11/15 KRGV test at 2:50; French-English mystery on 1150 and off at 3; Lille hrd 3-3:45; WJBO on NRC Special poor as usual with whistle QRM, announced a 2 hour monthly DX Program; XEMX 3:20-3:30 and signed in English; WPAB test at 3:30; KFAM at 3:32; Droitwich, England at 3:35; 11/16 WGRM test at 3:10; WBRK at 3:30-3:45; WLOF test at 4; 11/17 not up in AM but copied CKCO on top on 1310 at 7PM 11/18 Sick in bed all day. 11/19 Not up in AM because of illness but reported WFBR at 7PM and WBBR with very poor signal (only 15 miles away) at 7:15PM; 11/21 WEGO on NRC Dedication with R-9 plus signals and swell program. Felt good to hear one's name mentioned on a radio station again.

ORES WILSON-READING PA Veries rec in 1942 on reg sked CBY-KXEL-WNAB-WAPO WAJR-WJDX-WCED-WSUN-KTBS-WSBA-WWDC-WFIN-WISH-WIBC-WGAC-WJHL. WTOP this year and 826 in all. Those out are WBYN-WKNY-WOSH-WEGO. Bob Botzum is working 7 days a week in war work so guess only reports from Reading will be mine for a while. Only Radio Log I can get is Whites out here, seems to be very accurate and complete at 15¢ at news stands. 11/21 WEGO came thru moderate to strong, little fading and no interference, was a swell DX and most every word understood, same strength as WSAI. Wayne Nelson had fun running it, he lived in Bflo himself in the past. WAAT weak at 5AM; WHAS like local at 4:45, carriers everywhere, WWSW from weak to strong and fading. WRAW has vertical tower 176 ft high and rec a new coat of paint, Red-White chekerboard style located downtown atop Pomeroy's Dept Store, 2 blocks from my house, so they come in R-9 but only on 1340 kc and no where else on the band. My GE set is as sharp as a knife. Here is a little dope on WDRS in Boone, N C. Was operated by Kermit Dacus prop of Dacus Radio Service in Boone and was closed Oct 22 after being under surveillance by the FCC. It was located in the rear of the shop and was operating on a commercial basis according to Mr Myers, monitoring officer. Advertising local merchants and businesses. No doubt Mr Aasen went thru the audience mail files and perhaps verified them all (But Edge's report of 1/30/43) I noticed on the KOMO verie that KOMO & KJR were operated by same outfit. Their QRA is Skinner Bldg-Seattle, 1 Wash. Other veries in are WCHS-WGY-WSJS-WQXR-WHAZ-WOR. Late reports to CJRL-XEW-KFVD-WMAQ-KRLD-WIOD-WTIC-WBT-WWJ-KORN-WJLB-WSAZ-WEGO-KPO. The KJR verie of course does not count in the contest, I'm not attempting to re-verify any that I have for the contest, each verie will be a new one. There are so many that I dont have that it would be foolish to duplicate them. I could of course get more distance by duplicating the west coasters. CJRL was barely audible for terrific barrage of static and general noise. WEGO blasted in here and I hope I can hear KPOW and I do not have a Wyoming station verified. Got a kick out of the selection dedication (Oh Yes to you Norm was "Pistol Packin Mama") Hrd CJRL this AM It was terrible reception weathercut here, tho all sigs were fading rapidly and that noise was strong all the time. I would like some help on the signers of WAJR-WCRS, (E C Niemann, c.e. just signed mine for report of Nov 17th-Ray)- and the test times of WLAV-WSOO-WSNJ, some of the boys have reported them as verifying lately. (WGAC is located in Augusta, Ga according to letter head verie just rec here-Ray) Where was Lefty when WOSH gave their tips.
