DX Special.

The following is a letter in full as received from Mr. Wilbur Golson Chief Engineer of Radio Station WJBO on 1150 kcs in Baton Rouge, La. It will be appreciated if all you members cooperate with Mr. Golson and send him the information that he desires, in order that he may have the dope for his DX Specials for YOUR CLUB. Thanks Ray Edge Editor & Erenst R Cooper CPC.

TO NRC MEMBERS--;

Think its about time I was answering all these interesting letters you have been writing concerning the National Radio Club and my FCC-DX programs etc.

I really enjoy working with the club members and hope to do more for them in the future. As I mentioned on the air I have been working on a plan for regular DX programs for the club as I used to do several years ago. I had to promote the idea with my boss, the FCC and the Defense Command and finally have the approval of all. I have to run the FCC check each month and might as well run two hours as ten minutes, so selected that date and time for the NRC. The Defense Command has finally given their approval of the plan and I already have the OK from Van Nostrand Checking Concern, so starting with the December check on the 20th (Third Monday) I will be on the air from 2:00 - 4:00 AM EWT (Account of this conflicting with the KTW DX on same date Mr Golson has agreed to s-off Dec 20th at 3:10 AM EWT but starting in January it will be 2-4 AM EWT) The frequency will be checked during this program so it will serve two purposes.

Now I want this two hour show to be of real interest to the members, its their show so lets have the dope on the boys and girls?? are there any in the club? I have a file of the members and their nick names, jobs dope on their towns etc and want more of this type of info to talk about on the program. (To you members this list Wilbur has is quite old so please send him the dope as of to day, this means all of you-Ray) I also want more DX Tips to read and I'll have lots of time to talk about this during the two hours. I dont want the two hours filled with dry music, but want to talk to the DXers, mention them, their jobs, receivers, stations they have received, and even dope about their families so I can say hello to them if they care to listen in.

There are members in all directions from this station except, South, but we would like to run some tests and see what the results will be on reports received. We use a directional antenna array as you suspected. We have an egg shape pattern protecting Knoxville, Tenn. Our maximum signal strength is East-West. The tests will be announced and careful reports are requested as follows, general strength and volume on regular 5KW directional, say for 5 minutes, then I'll announce that the next test will be with 5KW non-directional, say for 5 minutes, then we can test at 1KW directional and also non-directional. I should think this will be of interest to the members as well as giving me a valuable report or reports on the operation of the station. All this can be done without stopping the broadcast.

About the F-M transmitter, I can it on the air if the members want to try for it. 1KW and call is WBRL on 44,590 kcs with antenna on top of WJBO's 485 ft tower. It has been heard from coast to coast during skip conditions, so they may be interested in this. WBRL's regular sked is 4-10PM EWT daily and is not on the air with the same program as WJBO except with some Blue Net shows. I can run the two stations at the same time, same program so if it is picked up it can be carrying the same program as WJBO and they wont have to do a lot of fishing around.

Mr. Wilbur Golson's letter continued.

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I have been running the programs from the recording turntables in another room in the transmitting plant and could not watch the transmitter, level and output as I should so I am installing a turntable in the transmitter control desk so that everything will be on hand to really run a DX Special in Dec. By the way, if any of the members have home recording machines, they can send me their personal greetings to be played on the DX Program. If they do not have a recorder they could have recordings made by some recording store that makes them. Suggest some one start this idea and others will follow. The recording should contain the following, description of receiving set up, facts about the town or city where located and then data on the stations received etc and and then they could say hello to other members, personal friends etc. I can play 33 1/3 or 78 RPM recordings but prefer 78 RPM.

Here's more. Note some members DX for Police Stations also, I designed and installed the Louisiana State Police Radio System and supervise its operation and maintenance and could help DX'ers (NRC Members) in logging these stations. Suppose on some future WJBO DX Program I work a tie in with the police stations in this state. Each one can be tuned in on WJBO and will come on the air for a test for the NRC when called upon. Each one will follow the other while WJBO stands by and the DX'ers tune to the police band to log each station. They are as follows, all on 1629 kcs. WLSP-Baton Rouge 1KW; KRAD-Alexandria, 500w; KSPF-Franklin-250w; KSPC-Monroe-250w; KSPB-Lake Charles-250w; KSPL-Leesville-250w. They will be instructed to announce some code word to serve proof of reception of the DX'ers.

I hope this brain storm of ideas meet your approval and that you will pass the word along to the proper persons in the club so we can get their comments or publicity on the plans.
