There was a Mex on 1430 at 3AM with fairly good sig as good as XEMX's. Who was this one "orm? WBAB was good on DX asking for earphones for the Army Air Corps Hospital in Atlantic City. I certainly hope some of us have a pair to spare to give them. Its a wonderful cause and it'll warm your hearts to know how much your gift will mean to some convalescent flyer. 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FRED VAN VOORHEES-WHITESTONE NY Reports coming in very slowly, no matter how many I send out. In the past week have been WEOA-WDLP-KVGB. Sent out reports to KNET-WBTM-WRRF-KICD-WBAB-XEBZ-CFJC-WBNX-WFPG. Hope some of those come back. Have 40 out now. Say is WTAM silent Sunday AMs or have they discontinued their 24 hr sked? To DAVE THOMAS on WAND try Florida State Board of Forestry, Tallahassee. I dont have this particular call listed but Florida Forestry has a number of similar calls on that freq. KICD program well received on 12/13 but KNET was pretty bad behind WNOE. Sent sketchy report tho. WRRF was good on 12/14 as was KHJ when WRRF s-off. WJLS on at 5AM asking for rpts, also copied WBTM from 5-5:30; 12/16 TA reception was excellent. Too bad we cant get veries from them. I list the ones I hrd under Freq Frolics. 12/16 copied WBNX and WFPG just before their respective s-offs. 12/19 WBAA tested at about 4:44; CFJC was very poor here, too bad overmodulation on part of WABC. Copied XEBZ on 660 kc as well as the very excellent program from WBAB. No go on KFMB, too much WNOE. (Well Lefty whats the matter on CFJC, Fred Got em-Ray)

JOE LIPPINCOTT-CELO NO CAR. So far I have received 112 veries this season. Of these some were duplicates such as WCEI. I was pleased to get verie from XELO, not that they are much in the way of DX but any station outside the US & Canada seems good with present conditions. For all members interest, if any station I list as verified in the contest is one that others need sked or want to know who signed, they can just mention it in the bulletin and I will send it for them via the bulletin. It takes a lot of time to list all skeds of stations verified. You see I use the double post-card and then some of the stations keep the cards and send letters. I dont like to receive letters very much unless from foreign stations. Most of the stations use business size envelopes and they are the duce to file. Many of them do not give the freq on which heard and they seldom give skeds or test programs. My return cards have a space to fill in daily and Sun skeds and tests or specials. Many of the stations fill these in and it is a great help. Of course it does not help me so much since by that time I have them verified but my log book looks lots better now with the skeds filled in. I surely have reported to a bunch of stations of late. I guess there are nearly 200 reports out or will be in a day or so. Best DX reported was KFMB. I have been running a kind of contest just for the fun of it to see which state provides the greatest number of stations hrd. At present I am counting in this bunch only those heard from here. There are 26 Calif; 25 Ohio; and NY; 24 Penn. Calif just took the lead this AM with ~~XXXX~~ KFVD. Was pleased to hear CFJC this AM. By the way how was anyone supposed to hear KFMB thru WNOE? Also one question I wish to ask. Are CPC men advised that it is not wise to arrange a DX program from a real DX station except in the 10 day or week period just before or a little after the full moon? I think KFMB might possibly have come in had it been about 3 days before the full moon which is the time when signals seem to be best. Stations of a 1000 watts or more have a fair chance of getting thru to the east even if it is not near the full moon but it is still a chance. I hope KTW comes thru as I need it but the 20th seems like a poor date for them. KVCV is certainly on a very poor date. It ought to be pushed up a week at the minimum. Since it is in December it may come in but I think it would be a whole lot easier on the ears to plan such DX programs when static can be expected to be low and signal strength high. CMBS on 1090 has been coming in well at times. WBAL just is not in the picture. Reception has been screwy of late. KGKO on 570 came right thru our local WWNC in the middle of AM. Today a Cuban was behind the NY Philharmonic from 3-4:30. There does not seem to be any station in the clear at times. Powerful stations are QRM ed by low powered ones. I am surprised at the volume with which WBZ comes in here at noon. Wishing all of you the Best fo the Season.

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STAN MORSS-BRADFORD MASS Before L Cooper has everyone spitting tacks, I'll say that the only CBAM ever hrd here was in Edmunston N.B. they use to use 20 watts, must have boosted power. Veries in from KPDN-WHBQ-KVGB-WGAC WSOC-WBIR. Reports are too numerous to mention, over 40 in last week and among them WHLD hrd here on Dec 15th at 4:30 PM and WPAX hrd testing on Dec 16 at 3AM. Radio Toulouse around 915 kc hrd here like a ton of bricks R9 plus Dec 16 at 3:30 AM. A French on 1215kc was R-5 Lille?; Britisher on 660 kc with Kentucky Minstral Selections R-5 at 4AM also on 16th.
