PAT REILLEY-JAMESTOWN N Y Had a touch of the Flu and didnt feel like DX-ing much. 1/20 WLAP but call letters not given often enough; WGCM at 4:31 checking; 1/21 WBIR at 3:10; WGBR at 3:10 on check; WSON on reg monthly check 3-3:30; WMFD at 3:32 on check; WMRC at 3:50 on check thru WJBK and WWSW; 1/22 WRDC tested nearly all AM; WJHO on reg monthly check 4:30-5; WHBU test 4:35; 1/23 Didnt hear KVGB but too noisy to DX today because of a wet snow falling; 1/24 Forgot to set alarm clock. Whats the trouble Dick with WISE, no slik handkerchief to her? 1/25 No DX, bad cold.

DAVE THOMAS-PROCTORVILLE O To BATSON-Frenchis on 1366 kc Boudeaux Sud-Ouset; Clevedon (BDC) on 1474; Two asked about Nice isxon 1185 kc. Lyons on 1393. The German asked about on 990 is THORN.
