To MALEY- I just received a veri from KGVO 1290 kcs, the date hrd was Jan 20th but I do not remember the time. This is in Montana, and the c.e. is Fred V Wamble, the engineer is Laurence Smith. Must have been after VLAP as I always listen to all the program on specials. On 910 kcs heard Ici Radio Talouce or Toluse. Anyone know who it is? They have sort of a bell or gong that rings 4 times. Does anyone know where I can get some recording blanks, I want to try to record some DX. Guess that would be better than writing them. I'm not rich but just like to spend money. 1/30 KFXM was no good here and neither was KGY. CKGB and WIGM came in R 5, also WFIN was very loud. 1/31 KHSL no good here. Additional veries here are from WSNY-KGO-KGVO-WJBO-WIND-WJR. Only 40 BCB veries and 6 on SW.

PFC ALEXANDER F MALEY 2/4 was an excellent morning with the coasters 45 Ft Putnam St coming in all over the dial with good volume. Highland Falls N Y KYUM was hrd solid on its check from 4-4:15 AM. KODY verie letter, picture of "Buffalo Bill" on the envelope and paper; KPRO included nice photo card with letter verie. KERN good; 2/4 KVGB not mentioned g NRC but good signal; WSAU good on check; WGRG tested and announcing as Louisville, Ky; 2/6 WMBG testing KFAC on reg sked, Milan, Moorside Edge, KLBW on NRC special came right thru WNOE for good program.
