HERB CAMPBELL added 2/22 Very heavy static, was station on 1230 kc with heave QSB which seemed to play band concert music KODL?? WAJR off test at 4:30; WHKY freq check at 5 and WGTN s-on at 5AM. (C nt answer you Herb as I had a heck of a job trying to get something by myself, got one selection, wont tell what it was till I hear from then-Ray)

HERB CAMPBELL-ATHENS PA A few more veries have come in during the past two weeks. KGNO in at last with curious PS informing me that KGNO is in Dodge City, not Ft Dodge. I know that, so what? Glad to get WEGO verie. Nothing said but think postcard shower worked. I didnt join in shower to CJRL (no report there) or WKNY as I offered them a gratis report. All late programs received except on 15th. Couldnt identify anything on 1230 which seemed to be at least 2 deep before WOLF came on. A carrier was on 1240. Went back to bed in disguist. JOE ENZ-BROOKLYN N.Y. Veries in from KLBW-WEGO. KLBW hrd as far as Dixfield, Me. 2/20 KTSW R-9 plus here, fine program boosting our club, hope one of our west coast members wins that Duke Ellington Album. Will send report but have them verified on their 1st day on the air, have letter & card from owner. WPAX also FB, must like Joe Becker also NRC 100% according to announcer. WDOD on 1310 testing till 5 AM. All coasters FB, one station on 1390 after KGER s-off, on till after 5AM. Hrd man and woman singing opera, anyone help me on this one? On 1240 after WPAX s/off, dance band and woman singing, fading out completely. Spicks on all over dial, one on 1460 XESM or XEXM??, carrier on 1470, also a new station on 1490 WJBK-WWSW and ????. Hrd it cut in at times. (KHBC is on 1230 kc Joe and can be hrd on Tuesday AMs when WITH is off, they s/off at 3:45 AM. KGMB on 590 and KGU on 760 kc but WRJ blocks this one.-Ray)

NEWT McLEOD-DIXFIELD, ME 2/15 no sign on CFAR, KHBC I think was speech on 1230 kc at 3:45 but too weak to copy. Nice carrier on but think WITH as it howled off and on. Hrd KID 3:05-3:15 better than the week before. Who is in back of KNX from 2:15-3 on Dec 16, seemed to be drama until 2:30 and then dance music to 3AM. Tnk it is a Blue affiliate but I might be hearing things. s/off 3AM. WKPT at 3:25 and WCRS at 3:30; 2/18 WCOS 3:05 3:10, test is 3-3:10 I guess. WFVA a cinch but I was half asleep and missed on or two titles. 2/19 Oh What A Beautiful Morning, but nothing new. All west coasters between 550 and 1200 coming in swell. Funny top of the band or is it the bottom? was dead That is from 1200-1600; Hrd KOY-KMTR-KGMB-KHQ-KFSD-KTAR-CKCK-KOH which usually arnt to be heard. CKCK was coming right thru KTAR-WSUN but all I hrd was their s/off. Odd I couldnt even hear CBK. To D COOPER-I've noticed too that a carrier will often smooth things out if it isnt so strong that it blocks my set. That German on 658 has helped me pull in KFAR a couple times, but I havent found anyway to muzzle that German. At least I think it was KFAR, I dont know who else is on at 3:30; Tried for an hour to find out who was in under KVOA on 1290 but gave it up. Whoever it was went off at 2:30 I think. That TA on 1295 isnt much help with all that long dried music. Notice a station between 590-600 which seemed to be a spick. No announcements, just a girl singing that sounded like she also had hiccups. By the way WABI is on 910 kc and not 1230 as listed. Moving day was April 41, and are supposed to be using 5KW. But it doesnt sound that way to me.

JIM SHUPE-DAYTON O DX picked up lately since 2/1/44, hrd 18 new stations. They are WBIR-WCOV-WGAC-WFOY-WDWS-WTAW-KGKO-KCKN-KVGB-WBLK-WMGA-KASA-KWJB-WMVA-KGFL-KWYO-WEBQ-KOKO. So far this season I have hrd 69 new stations and 7 new states. Veries in from WEBQ-WBLK-KGKO-WGAC-WBIR-WLAY. Where can I get a list of regular freq checks? I have used up the ones listed in DX NEWS. Does XELO verify? I still need 15 states to complete USA. Whata should I use for as postage for Mexican and Canada. I am hearing a lot of them and would like to verify some. (On the Mexicans Jim I send a 5¢ and to Canadians I send Canadian stamps 4¢-Ray. I have some Canadian Stamps here, if you want some just send an extra 3¢ stamp for return postage. It costs 4¢ to come back from Canada, so that is what you should enclose to them.-Ray)

These were also on 2/21 KTSW-WPAX-XEDF F.B.. 2/21-1:30 AM SA on 1070kc. 1010 kc also spick but KDKA test covered em up. On 1250 a Mex. What are these stations? 2/21 WJBO-WALL F.B. SULLY SULLIVAN-PITTSBURGH PA Got a verie from WEGO for Special but I suppose the rest did too. On Saturday rec 2 very fine booklets. One the Vacationland booklet that Grant mentioned and sent from WSAU and the other an even finer one from WDSM on Radio At War. WDSM also sent a very fine personal letter as wekk as a letter of verification. KTUC sent a page from the Tucson Daily Citizen showing their half page advertisement. WFOR also sent verie card. New reports to KLX-KROW-XEDF-KOH which is the first report to a Nevada station)-KTAR-WPAX-KTSW-WALL-WJBO. All new except WJBO. Total veries now 249. Had 137 when the season opened in Oct.

GORDON STEARNS-CHESTER DEPOT VT Veries in are KVGB-WMGA-WDBO-WISE and a very good letter from Murry Durham, c.e. of KLEB. That is the first station using 250 watts that I have from that far away. KNX does not come in as good as KLEB did. To JOE BRAUNER-WQRT is a Police Station in Boston using 500 watts on 37,500 kcs. Tnx to James McNamara for the dope on record blanks. Also I think it is about time I thanked Stan Morss for his welcome card. I kept forgetting it and kept seeing where he has sent others a card and thanked him. Please excuse the delay STAN. I sure would like to know D.C. and D.T. get in so good with WISE. All I got was a card and maybe I did not try to get more-Hi. It was a good card though. Tnx to D COOPER for the DX CARD on XEDF. I got them 50% or so. 2/15 KFBC no good here; 2/18 WFVA has an R-8 sig here; 2/20 KTSW R-5 here; 2/21 WJBO R 5-6 with hetrodyne from Spick station and lack of selectivity on my receiver. Also same night WALL came in R 8, some of the time and then WEXL completely covered them up at other times. Jack Craig's recording over WJBO came in very clear and loud. (That was a surprise and how)

JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N Y DX this past wekk ranged from fair to ordinary. On club specials WFVA was R-8 and seemed to be in the clear. KTSW likewise was strong and clear and WPAX made a third, all three giving perfect reception and WPAX deserving credit for an unusually interesting program, something different. Something different also from XEDF whose announcements surprised me so much that I took him for some nearer American station, untill the call was given. Signal good, but had strong 60 cycle buzz on that section of the dial, both noise and signal about R-6 making it quite a job to make out anything here. For those Montana seekers KGEX held forth all morning with an R-7 signal recalling again the time about 15 years ago when this same call came from Wolf Point, with an R-8 signal despite only 10 watts behind it, and a temporary antenna here. XELO hrd s/off on 800 kc at 2:26 AM. All this on 2/20; Tried for WALL on 2/21 but no luck, listened steadily for 20 minutes but no such call or DX hrd on 1340 kc. New veries this past week, CBJ and WEGO, both letters, also letter verie from KLEB, unrequested, and a refusal from KPPC, both these stations had courtesy reports from me, both being told not to verify, and no space was used to give them verification data. Veries now overdue from WING-WHLN these two are almost pre-war holdouts-CJRL-CJFX-KPAS. Not too bad, all things considered.

HAROLD BURSTROM-E CLEVELAND O Heard from Leo Herz last week and he's OK. Said he was on a 7 day furlough and had meet Stone. Working same hours every day, but have done some DXing. Reports out for WAAC-KASA-WSAP-KTSW-WFVA which came in R-9 plus, gave them a whole hours report. Veries in from WEGO-KICD-CHPS-KODY-CFBR-WSNY-CKVD-WLDS-KYOM. Hope to be able to get up for some more. We are just crawling out of the snow storm.

AL BARTHOLOMEW-BRADFORD N Y No DX lately, noisy as duce. Was CFAR or KFBC on? Verie back from WEGO, nice letter after sending follow-up, sent them also to CJRL-CJFX and guess I'll report KODY again. Didnt hear XEDF here. Yes for me DX has been rotten. (No Al KFBC not on but will be the 28th)

DR JOHN WM KIRK-POINT PLEASANT W VA 2/21 This AM hrd WJBO as I was riding back from Charleston to Pt Pleasant. Reception out in the country was so darned much better than at home that I wish that the drive had lasted longer. I hope that everyone tuned out of WJBO sometime during the program and got the station on 650 kc that was broadcasting then. That was a nice catch for a car radio, I think. I couldnt get it at all at home due to power line noise. Since last report veries in from KTUL-WNAX-WLOK-HOK-WOC-WWSR-CJCB-WEMP-CKRC-KYUM-XEXT more about this later on)-KECA-WFOY-WINN-WRAL-WTSP-CRB-KLBM-KWAT-KGBS-WMAN. Not many going out though so my next few reports will without doubt be shy. Just too darned much power line noise to DX. Abt XEXT. Got a very nice letter from them verifying my reception on Nov 23rd Verie dated Feb 3rd. They had as much difficulty reading my letter in English as I had in reading their letter in Spanish. They operate with a effective power of 1KW on 980 kcs, however in Tepic there is a power defeciency (lo unico male que tenemos en esta ciudad es la energia electrica que esta muy deficiente) and as a result they are often forced to operate with a power of 100 w. They are glad to get reports, but do have great difficulty in getting them translated from English to Spanish. If at all possible anyone reporting should use Spanish. WALL no good here this AM. However I didnt stay up for their entire check, just tried for the first 15 min or so. Had been in Charleston all day in conferences with the W Va State Association, and just too tired to stay up any longer. Only managed to get 2 1/2 hours sleep last night. Hope to have some specials from down this way before too long. Have been working on some for the club. Maybe they will come thru. Sure hope so. If they do I may try to be in the studio for one or more of them. Finally got my copy of DX Almanac this AM. For those of you who havent as yet ordered it, you are really missing something.

SULLY SULLIVAN-MAYBE THIS WILL CATCH ME UP WITH YOU*Ray) Other veries in are from WJMC-WSIX-WDSM-WRAL-WFBR-WISE special-WLVA-KSJB-WRDO-WOKO-KWAT-KLCN-WKAR-WIP-WLAP-KRSC-WPAY-WJLS-WBTM. (OK on WHIZ-Ray) Reports went out to WFOR-WMSL-KWLC-KTNM-KOL-KTUC-KVOO-CKGB-KFUN-VONF which was hrd on 2/4 sometimes on top of KFI. Believe they were on all night.
