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JOE BRAUNER-WILLIAMSVILLE N Y Not much to report this week, little time to listen, CHEX ran into severe static, which eat up the program very badly, lots better here in daytime, same R-8 strength, no static. KPQ not hrd my set is not very hot at that end of the dial. KSUB ran into too much QRM for me. WMRF nowhere near as good as in Dec, easily logged, but mostly behind WJBK, last time it was the reverse. KFBC ran into another static ridden night, remarkable signal here, easy R-7 which is something for that power and distance, just as loud as WITH, but static also R-7 and made the most interesting program of the season very noisy. Static seems to be getting off to an early start this year, lots of noisy nights lately. KFBC only new one this week, only one verie in and that a duplicate, nice letter from WFVA. Tx to Stan Moss and Gordon Stearns for dope on WQRT, but with that freq, they will be one more that I'll not hear, cant even get the local police xmitter, less than 1500 ft from my home, have only hrd VMJ's relay on this band, and a former BC relay operated by WBEN, plus a couple Ham stations on 5 and 10 meters.

CMC, Havana on 1360 kc at 4:30 AM; WHN testing on 1050 kc-5:15AM KSUB behind WEXL, hard to copy, have them verified quite a few years, will send tax card/ Believe it or not fell asleep in my easy chair and my wife called me at 7:30 AM, missed WMRF special. Station on 1240kc, could not get call, Spick on 1260 kc strong, also station behind WNOE ar 3AM. On Mon AM the 28th KFBC was R-6, western selections, Lady announcer on till after 4, got plenty for a report. KFVD on 1400 kc at 2:30; WBIG-1460 kc at 4:30 AM. Unknown testing on 1400 kc at 5AM.

A list of Freq checks is in Feb 15 issue of URDCX bulletin. (Would copy them buy have not the time-Ray) To MEL OLIVER-Are you sure that your station hrd on 650 kc was CX6 on 2/21? I hrd this station too here it was something elxe, or else CX6 was also on in addition to my catch. Your Cuban on 1610 kc is also hrd here, as near as I can make it out the call is CMRT. A letter from KGBS says they will plan on dedicating their next 2 freq checks to the NRC. Will be on Mar 8th and Apr 12th. at 4:10 AM EWT. Mr Spencer has a lot of nice things to say about the NRC, so try emm on both dates. Since last Oct 25th have verified every state-DC-P.R.-3 Canadian Provinces-4 Mexicans states-Bahamas-Panama and Newfoundland. Not such a bad season. Have 2 veries from WELL now, didnt verify my first report. until now WACO sent their sked for that week and post card pictures of their city. EKKO stamps from KFJZ-KLX-WDAE. WTBO marked verified on rpt.

I organized the ARA in 1941 and during the latter part of 1942, I took over the BCB section of VRC. "Alla my verifications so far are of stations broadcasting on their reg program sked except for about 10 special DX programs. I hope to get in on all NRC tests now and build up my log. As to SW, do very little and only logging, no veries, about 100 of them. Latest veries are KPO-WAAT-XEB-WLOK-KFAC-WCAE-XELO-CJBC-WOWO-WOC-WHKY-WJJS. About the ARA. Well worth the 50¢ and while it does not agree with some of the testing dates of some of the stations according to my own experience, it sure does open up new territory for me.
