LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N Y Veries from WIGM-WFVA. Reports to KOAM 2/29- tried for CFAR & KFAR but no go on either one. KOAM was on from 5-6 at Jack Quintrell's request for the NRC, but didnt mention club probably because F C C wouldnt let em. (What do you mean they didnt mention the club? If you listened to it all you would have heard them, at 4:21 AM when they Extended Greetings to the N R C-Ray) They had to get permission from FCC and WGY for the "Test" program as they called it. KOAM was R-7, CRMed by WNEW's image which is 320 kcs lower then their reg freq. The 1290 kc WAAT image I get is 320 kcs higher then their reg freq, so there must be some connection. For DICK-WNAB s/off at MDT and no freq check.

GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD N Y Dx has been poor the last 2 weeks, man what static, but a few reports. 2/25 WJAG freq ck 2-2:15 under high powered WBAL; 2/26 CHEX on NRC DX, bad QRM, a good deal poorer than ordinary daytime reception; 2/27 WMRP NRC-DX, not as good as previous one; 2/28 KFBC NRC-DX well hrd despite static with typical western program; 2/29 WATN on 1240 kc 2-2:15 check, who said they were not on? This adds 7 new ones to my log, KFBC letter says, compliments of the DX-ers on Sharp Ears for solid copy.

JACK CRAIG-OAKLAND CALIF Veries in from CBK-CFCN-KFBK-KGMB-KIUP-KROD-KVGB-KWAT-WDSU-WEEI-WHAI-WIAC-WJAX-WPDQ-WYMV all hrd in Erie; Here in Oakland, reports are out to CHEX-KFBC-KSUB-KTRH and WMRP. I hope all of you heard KFBC. Mrs Wolf gave a very interesting program, telling all about Wyoming. WMRP was only h-3 Q-2 out here. I could hear that preacher on WJBK too, but I didnt sent them a report. I visited KFBC and their engineer likes our reports. Said they have been receiving some lately from Australia. Also visited KQW's San Francisco studios, also KSAN. I got a letter from KHSL saying that my report did not check with their station log. Said they had news on them. Wasnt our program from them to be after their reg s/off time? (How about it LEN KRUSE????)

DR JOHN WA KIRK-POINT PLEASANT W VA Not an awful lot to report. Veries in from KOAM-WEEI-KSKY-WKAT. Not many going out as I have been busy and I still have my power line noise. Maybe hrd CFAR, have report in and hrd WMUR on s/on, then too much WAYS and WIOD. WAYS signing on same time as WMUR sure wrecked this test for me. AM of 2/29 was practically perfect for DX, so dont know why they did not come in for me. Dave Thomas (35 miles from here) got 7 of the IDXS specials. That is sure good going. I did maybe hear the one on 191 kc (at least hrd a carrier there) but could not pull it through. However, my long wave is no good anyway, so I really didnt expect to get any of the long wave stations. Did not get a positive verie from WMUS. They had a card all made out for me, stamped and everything, they were sure I would hear them. however only got their carrier, unmodulated and could not give definite proof of reception. Maybe I can get them some other time. AM of 2/29 did get KROY-KGFJ-KGMB and a few other catches, even though I did not fare so well on the IDXS test. 3/7 Nothing hrd on WSLB & KWON, will try for KGBS this AM. Thomas cleared up the Canadians on 1170 kc, They are images and not on 1170 kcs.

Will send some 40 signers to Blanchard. 2/26 WJHO fb thru heavy static; 2/27 KIL0 caught freq check for Kansas City 2-2:30, may have been earlier, will repeat Mar 26th on 4th Sunday. WINN ditto 2:30-3. Swell AM no static; WMRF good on special, telephoned them and announcer hrd program over fone for few minutes. 2/28 KODY swell 2-2:15; KFBC good thru heavy static, copied whole program (verie back already) 3/4 WWDC s/on 6AM; WJHP caught 6:21; WPDQ-6:45; 3/5 WINX at 6:48 carrier, s/on at 7; WJRM s/on 7:22; WSGA at 6:58; 3/7 Copied off report WAKR while waiting. Lots of static, auts. Hope KWON comes thru. Incidentally work in 7 night stretches 5:45-5:45AM. 12 hours, so only DX is on 2 nights off between stretches, 3/7 cont 1:35 CHLN testing, classical music; 2AM WSLB behind terrific static, got enough for verie just; 2:30 Hrd KWON come on but thats all I can say, music unidentifiable, will try next month. Raining and sleeting hard, 3AM phooey, to bed. I am right next to Sullivan machine Co and when they are working the radio sounds like someone pouring cold water into boiling fat Ham fryer. Veries in from WALL-KOA and reports out to KPO-KDYL-KFBC. Did not get under CFJC's wall. I could get sigs on their freq but not good enough to copy. KGVO on 2/27 3:01-3:15; WJLD on 2/27, 2nd time, good reception from 7:05-7:30 AM; 2/28 KODY at 2:01-2:15 KFBC 3-3:58, terrific static; WATW on 2/29 2-2:15; KHMO on 3/1 3:30-4; Also on 3/1 WJPR 3:59-4:10. Have written them all. WFNC verie red 2/29 by W C Ewing, manager, they check 4th Fed 4:30-5AM;

FRANK WHEELER-ERIE PA Reports since last time out to WCFI-WHP-WAKR. Received CHEX ok on their club DX but too much WIND for KPC and too much WEXL for KSOB, that is if they were on. WAKR came in h-9 with WJBK interfering a little in background. KFBC came in h-9 thru a barrage of static. This was a new one for me. They gave a swell program.
