They advise that as yet they have not been assigned a freq check period but I'll watch out for it. Will be glad to see this hot summer over so DX will appear again.

JACK CRAIG-QRA on front page A verie just came from CFAC for a report I sent them in Feb 4th. A follow up sent in May. They said both reports had been side tracked and mislaid and were sorry about it. I was able to hear them in Erie and they said they were surprised to get out that far. Dont know Marsh Blanchard's QRA so here is the verie signer for him,-- Earle C Connor, Tech 4ir. With all these new stations on the air should add lots of new life to DXing and I would certainly go for a twist at the old dials. PFC EDWARD J WYMAN-Qra on front page Well I'm in New Guinea and here is a station for you boys to shoot at, it operates on 1480 KCS with 200 w and operates from 5-6:30PM EWT; 9-11 PM EWT and 3-8 or 9AM EWT. Lets see you DXers get this one. Call is 2GI. All English broadcast mainly news. Really enjoy the bulletins so as to find out whats going on home. We dont have a receiver capable of picking up the Aussies and I miss it.

JIM WEDEWER sends in dope on WENT;- WENT-1340 kcs 250 watts located in Gloversville N.Y. with xmtr at Hamison Extension, near Gloversville, the studios are located at 8 West Fulton St and owner is Sacangaga Broad-Conn and went on the air July 24 1944.

BILL GABRIEL-CLEVELAND O Well finally time for a report. Got in from Mexico the last part of July. The following may be of value in writing to Mexican stations and also may clear up things. I believe the big reason more veries are not received from Mexico is because the stenographic depts of the stations dont speak English and do not bother to hunt up an announcer or executive who does, but merely toss them away. Things are not done very throughly in Mexico. Another good reason is that a great part of the Mexican populace do not care for Americans, believe it or not. We were not treated in Mexico as visiting Mexicans would be treated in the U.S. We found for the most part, the only "Good Neighbor" policy, is right here in the U.S. A 3rd reason is the fact that the post office system is undependable. A letter addressed simply "Station XERC, Mexico City" will usually end in the dead letter basket, or in a few cases be returned... They do not bother to hunt for missing QRA's, especially in large cities. Therefore, here are 3 rules which might be wise to follow when writing to Mexico. 1-Address your letters thus, "Gerente or Director, Radiodifusora XEXX, Calle Blank # 1, Mexico, D.F., Mexico". 2nd-Write in Spanish using Steve Mann's letter which was published in your bulletin some time ago, and 3rd try to know the address or company licensee of the station when writing to a large city. No DX lately-didnt have access to a radio down there. Did visit some stations which I'll tell you all about in my next report. Have been spending for follow-ups to stations failing to verify this past season. One has answered already, CJHI, sent a letter of verification signed by Howard Clark, manager for the Nov 22 DX. So you might try again. C E John Bull is no longer with the station. Now if KWSC KHBC and a few others come across, I'll feel OK ~~xxxx~~ Think I'll get up for WROX this month and if I get a verie, I'll try for a DX with Lefty's permission of course. While I think of it I wonder if some woe-begotten Brooklyn fan can tell me WHAT'S WRONG WITH THE DODGERS? Well until the next thrilling installment on the "Mexican Situation" I'll sign off.

ELBERT TEWELL-CAREY O. It has been a long time since I last wrote and I dont remember if I ever told about myself. Will be 27 years old in Oct marries and have 3 children(all girls, just like Pop Edge) work in the local Porcelain Products Inc. My job is that of a kiln piacer which is very hot place to work. After coming home from there I go to work in my own Radio repair shop, which sure in a busy place. So far I have been able to get almost all sets out despite the radio tube shortage. I do a lot of substituting and re-wiring though in order to get them all out. My mott motto is KEEP EM PLAYING for I know how much a radio means to folks who have members of their families in the armed services. My only brother lost his life in the Italian campaign. As to DX, there has been none since the close of the season in April. During past season I hrd most of the NRC specials and reported all I hrd, receiving veries from all reported. Of all reports that I out last year all have been answered but one WDLP. Received used is a 9 tube home made affair and us a 125 ft single wire antenna 15 ft above the ground and runs East-West, also use a 15ft pole antenna which performs very well. I use it whenever the noise level is very high as it greatly reduces the noise.

ORES WILSON-READING PA No new veries or DX out here but here is some dope on DX. Local WRAW is running all day with baseball broadcasts to fill in the afternoons. Have their 1st lady announcer and one of the engineers has left to join WHP's staff. WEST used to be WKJC in Lancaster and was dismantled and moved to Easton around 1936. WJAN & WCBA were 2 seperate xmtrs and both in same room. The ann would sign off one, get up, walk across the room and s/on the other. Local police station WPTL, 100w just moved its antenna from atop City Hall to atop our famous Mt Penn which overlooks the downtown part of Reading. The Skyline Drive commands a high full view for miles around and is main attraction to visitors. (CONT)

He was an ex-swapper with the New Zealand forces in Egypt. Has been released after 3 1/2 years of service. The summer is surely going and soon a new DX season will be here again. Have no room for an outdoor antenna right here. Maybe we'll move before winter and get one.

C.E. SLEICHTER-DEL PASO HGTS CALIF Air conditions very bad for DX but still get XEBS-XEBC-WDSJ with good volume and for SW fans. Government is adding 2 new units to the US station at Dixon, call letters to be KNIB & KNAB, also a new bldg at Delans the most powerful SW station in the U.S. Been busy with W.P. messages from Japan and Germany, have been getting Japan messages filed before Xmas and have forwarded hundreds of them to home addresses. VLG-3 comes in R8-9 with JZK next. BCB is my meat not SW but have some good catches at that. Is it true KXO is on 1250 kc, if so KYA now on till 1AM will shut them out to me. I first arc them on 1200kc 14 years ago, never have hrd them since. In checking I find I have hrd 845 US-PR-Hawaii and Alaska and 229 foreign, that is other than US. 2 in Argentina; 1 Guate; 1 Phillipine; 49 Canadian; 98 Mexican; 33 Cubans; 4 from New Zealand; 3 China; 25 Japs; 12 Aussies; 1 Costa Rica.

JAMES KADEF-CLYVELAND O My first year and half of DXing ended successfully with 397 stations hrd and 99 verified. There isnt much of interest on the BCB now. NORM MAGUIRE-INGLEWOOD CALIF The past season was sure swell with regards to DXing. With aid of the Club specials, we were presented with some mighty fine catches. I believe that the gang responsible should again be thanked, so I extend my thanks to the CPC especially Lefty and Dick Cooper, Joe Becker, Len Kruse-bill Gabriel for their efforts, also to Pat Reilley and Joe for their handling of the Club affairs. Last but not least to Pop for getting out the best DX bulletin going and for handling the other Club affairs from Buffalo. Congratulations to Norm Kernoodle for winning the BCB contest. He did a nice job altho the winning milage was sure low this year. (Account of not using the number of specials verified as multipliers) Incidentally I noted that the following stations were verified in the contest and would like to find the verie signers as these stations failed to verify for me, this past season, WSLI-WDSU-KODY-WIAC. I'm in accord with Dr Kirk on verifying or at least trying to verify anything under any conditions. Foreign reports are sure scarce and they wouldnt overload the mails. Is that the title of Dave Thomas' thesis, or did your typewriter get stuck? Boy what a title.

DR JOHN KIRK-PT PLEASANT W VA Thanks a lot fellows for all the letters re the question of whether or not to verify the foreign stuff. The count now is 19 to 1 in favor of verifying such stations. The one holdout incidentally has informed me that in the past season he has verified stations in Hawaii-Canada-Cuba-Haiti-D.R. and US. So even though he says he is opposed to verifying foreign stuff he seems to do so. Personally I know that I continue to verify foreign stuff when ever I can do so. I believe that I will quote part of some of the letters that I have received- this from Joe Lippincott, "I'm most certainly in favor of reporting as many stations as I can war or no war. As a matter of fact I have used the war period to concentrate on stations that could ve verified such as US and Canada but only because I did not want to waste my money writing to foreign stations and then have the censor take over my report enroute. I use International reply cards with data about myself and my radio hobby and just enough about the station to proove I heard it. As far as principles are concerned, I would report to any station I thought I could get verified. I agree with you that there are not many active DXers now and most of them are not reporting many foreign stations so it will not be much of the job for the censors. But if it was a big job, so what? I consider it an inwarranted curtailment of our freedom to refuse to let our reports go through." Paul Kary writes me, "I have decided to send all reports via airmail to all stations who have not answered, but should have answered by now." I believe that the above examples are enough to proove my point that the 19 fellows writing me expressing their desire to verify foreign stuff are sincere in their convictions. Incidentally to any of you who have not as yet received a personal note of thanks I will send them along to you just as soon as I can find time to do so. Till then this will just sort of have to do. Reception is pepping up some now. Signals are coming in much better and am again getting some fairly good stuff. Sort of seems that season is maybe going to get off to an early start. Last nite (Thurs) WHOM was putting in a nice signal at their s/off at MDT. First time hrd for a long time. Also hrd this wk are such stations as the usual list of Calif, TGW-KOH-KGU-KGMB. Signal strength has been high and noise level not too bad. Did have power line noise for about 2g weeks but got GE engineers in here and they found it for Power Co. Who is facsimile station on WLW Mon 8/7 at 10-10,30PM. Hrd em very faintly thru WLW sig. Also who is carrying WLW programs on 1175kc between 8-9AM. Hrd em a few times thru WWVA a local, seem to s/off with WLW announcement and never give Call of their own. Sig usually poor but fair quality. Tnk its illegal outfit but not sure. Have a dickens of a strong harmonic on 2350 kc and packs a wollop in here. Hrd last wk July.
