CHUCK BENDER-PITTSBURGH PA Dx here has certainly picked up since Labor Day Kittanning convention. Incidentally, dont let Lefty kid "POP" Edge about that bridge over the Conemaugh that we crossed on the way home. He turned six shades of green before we got started. A total of twenty five reports were sent out during September. Veries in so far include WHA-WJZ-WOR-WMMN-WOL-WIP-WHBQ-CKAC-WHIO-WCOV-WONK-KGBS-KLRA-WNAC-WFEA. Reports still out are WBNF-WBR-WJBY-WGAC-KALB-VALC-KICD-WEED-WBJS & KFH. The best DX morning in a long time was Sept 11th when WJBY-WBIR-WCOV-WGAC-WFOY-WONK-KALB and KGBS were heard in order on ten minute frequency checks from 3:05 until 4:25. WNAC and WFEA were heard with storm warnings during the hurricane and coincidentally both veries were received the same day.
