NOTICE

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It has been noted with interest by your CPC Chairmen that dedications of freq check programs are not receiving reports in nearly the numbers that regular DX programs are. Several members have suggested to me (directly and indirectly) that we discontinue such dedications. They say after all a station that can be heard every month is not exactly an incentive to roll out of bed for and report, especially when that station has already been verified. I myself have found getting up for freq checks difficult, maybe even boring, but I continued to do so and to report. The only reason for these dedications was that it offered the club publicity and gave us a chance of getting our message across to non members among the DX fraternity. Since the "no's" outnumber the "yes" I have decided to call a halt to these dedications, but those already scheduled will be dedicated to us. Those for KORN-WCBI-WHOP-KBWD-WAJR-KGBS will go on as previously arranged. While KSJB is being postponed to December, because there are 2 other programs for us that morning and we dont want to make a marathon morning on November 14th, at the risk of cutting down reports to one or more of the stations involved. So we will schedule no more Freq checks, unless a station is willing to dedicate to us without receiving a lot of reports. (For Pick and Dave) This does not apply to WISE. We want Betty Freeman with us anyhow. My sincere thanks to the boys who expressed themselves re these check dedications. I for one am sorry to see them go as they did publicize both your club and your DX programs. However, the majority rules and it always will as long as I am your CPC Chairman.

DICK COOPER-KITTANNING PA Verie in from WHOT and reports out to KFNF and WCAL. KFNF was hrd during recent Cuban hurricane for the first time I've been able to copy them since I started to verify. Used to hear them often in the early days of radio but it was one that I passed up. Likewise WCAL hrd for first time, signing on at 7:30 AM EWT and covering WJZ like a tent. I think the spick on 1410 during the hurricane was CMHB, Sancti Spiritus. Most of the Havana stations were off for several days. Pat Reilley's station on 640 kcs is VONF. Have hrd them break thru several times and they s/off at 9:30PM approx. Fred Van Voorhees report is a pippin and really appreciated. Puzzeles over WKAC San Juan P.R. on 600 kc however. Is that a licensed station Fred?? FCC never listed them, also the Bermuda station would be a great one for a DX program. Would suggest that nothing would be lost in DX programs from any of those stations that operate on a channel that is clear.

TOM MORRISON-CLEVELAND OHIO I sure did miss the bulletins but havent had a whole lot of time to DX. Been busy since becoming an announcer at WBOB Americas Pioneer School station. They operate on 42,500 kcs with 1 KW. Was up on 10/27 from 4:30-5:15 EWT and managed to get KFAC on 1330 kcs and WRLC on 1450. Much static but no good DX. Tried early evening force change and on 10/31 logged WFEA on 1370 kcs behind WSPD's at 8PM, also CMHK on 1380 kc from 7:30-8:30PM. Signal was Q 2-4 and R-5. Couldnt get a report though. (OK Tom and lets hear from you often and good luck on your announcing job.-Ray)

JIM MCNAMARA-CLAREMONT N.H. Reports out to WAJR-WKEU-WMRF-KGGF-WWNY-WRLC and veries in from WWNY-WINN-WBNS-WCAE-WRLC-KPO-WAJR-WHIO-KVOR-KLYL-WMBG-WFVA; WMRF came in fair and were QRM'd by WJBK. I cant get rid of them on 1490 kcs. I try all 8 leads but no difference. Well I got enough of them to report anyway. I really like the way they put over a program, much the same as WJBO. They are swell too. I did not heer WINN listed on the DX Calendar. Got a letter from Stearns today, so he is alive. He needs an alarm clock to awaken him so he can DX a little. I see WAJR will be on 1230 kcs after March 29th, this from verie.

PAT REILLEY-JAMESTOWN N.Y. 10/25 picked up WKLA for a new one at 4AM, reported to WWNY for the club special. Fixed up a new antenna after work today (Well look out boys now comes some DX reports from Pat) 10/26 KPOF testing at 3:20, copied XEBC on 1590 for a new one. Northern lights causing bad buzzing here. 10/27 KUSD testing at 2:45; KXA giving WJZ a tussel at 3, copied Spick on 1020 kc until KFVD gave their call at 3:15. more bad fading today; somebody on 790 after KECA signed at 3 but couldnt copy because of bad fading; 10/28 very noisy and weak signals today; 10/29 up at 4 and fell asleep in front of set, didnt hear WMRF for club; 10/30 out 2 late the night before to a party. XEX-KAVE and WKLA all back today for 1298 log. XEX is Estociera Radiodifusora XEX-Hercldo del Comercio, S.A. Apdo 628-Monterrey, N.L. Mexico and signed by Carlos R O A. Departamento Tecnico. BOB BOTZUM-READING PA Well I didnt hear WDBC on 1490 kcs according to Hank Olson, c.e.. WDBC broadcasts daily 6:30AM-12MDT. Also says they have no tests of DX broadcasts planned for the duration. Darn tough trying to land him on 1490 kcs at 6:30 AM.

 port-KTYW-TIBAS-WGOV (2 reports out)-WLOF overdue-#300 and XEJP. Mornings

S/SGT AL MALEY-HIGHLAND FALLS N.Y. The freq check list I am preparing is  
 really coming along fine now. The original list has undergone quite a  
 face lifting and is almost ready for publication, but it is my suggestion  
 or intention to wait another month until I can hear from some more of  
 the fellows I sent the old list out to. It has been very gratifying to  
 hear from all you fellows about various changes and additions, and it  
 goes to show the fine measure of cooperation prevalent among our members.  
 I sent out about 35 copies of this list to various members whose CRA  
 could be tracked down in my copies of DX NEWS. However I am sorry to say  
 that there were many more members I would have liked to have sent copies

ROBERT W. BRKYMAIER-CHICAGO ILL. There hasn't been anything to report for I haven't been able to do any DXing for ages. At present I am stationed at Navy Pier here in Chicago. How long I will remain here is problematical. I'm teaching Radar at the radio material school on the pier. Even tho I'm working with radio every day I have no time to do any tuning. I have no radio here and there aren't any good facilities for radios but then I get home every once in a while so that I should be able to do some tuning this season. The bulletin has been coming OK. (OK Bob glad to see that you are going along OK and more good luck to you from us all-Ray)

GRANT BATSON-WESTFIELD N Y Just starting to DX, on Oct 25th hrd WWNY with the club special, very well hrd. 10/29 WMRP DX really pounded in here, only 3 brief moments did CRM from WJBK, but at 6:58 others signed on and finished off good reception. I do like to get these H-9 signals like WMRP. Again I tried for Sarnia, Ont on 1070 kcs at 4 PM on Sunday and CBA overrode WIBC, is this station (Sarnia) on the air yet?? WWNY verie back in 3 days; 10/28 9-10 PM WSM and WHO QRM'd by S.A. stations and WGN also partically blocked. Better have your bulletin come first class mail, boys mine gets here before the cancellation mark is dry.

BOB SPENCER-BUFFALO N Y I put up an outside antenna from the house to the garage, about 50 ft at least. Have the lead in off the Northeast, which is nearest the house. Mailed reports to WROX-WWNY-XEG-WMRB-WSYR-WBAB-CKEY-CBF CBL-WGY and since last report WLAY. Veries received from WISE-KORN-WHBC. Antenna seems to work out quite well, having tried it only one evening. Put down some linolium this evening. WQWT Erie County's WERS is restricted to 40 meters and will test this week under WEBR's c.e. Ray Lamy.

LEFTY COOPER-BROOKLYN N Y Second letter in from Mr. Ashbacher of WKLA, and he says they are actually on the correct freq, but still set up a heterodyne against other stations on 1450 kcs. He is definitely off freq tho for VNOE-KRIC & WRLC have all been heard while WKLA was on and WKLA could be tuned in separate from them all. 10/25 WWNY came in swell here-scarcely any fading and good loud signal. WKLA was hrd that same morning on 1452 kcs. 10/29 WMRP came in so well here that WJBK could scarcely be heard at all. Mr. Dopp can certainly run an interesting program and he is to be commended for this one. 10/26 I had the pleasure of a visit from Fred Van Voorhees and we went over Al Maleys check list and found a couple of differences in ours. Fred is a swell fellow and his visit was every minute a pleasure. Len Kruse dropped in again ~~xxxx~~ Sunday, but I was away visiting relatives in Rahway N.J.. I'm sorry to have missed him. We're dropping the freq check dedications, except for WISE, so now fellows please don't forget that you should write to every station on the air for us. (OK Lefty, now we will have a little contest, see who misses the least of the specials-Ray)

DAVE THOMAS-PROCTORVILLE O If anyone heard a station QRMing WWNY on their DX on the 25th, it was 4YA. He was copied solid here from 4:20-5:23 on that AM. 1YA is excellent almost daily now. 5:30 AM on. Putting up another BEVERAGE WAVE beamed directly on NORTH AFRICA and CENTRAL CHINA. Took 2 men 1/2 day just to unroll the wire and place it over ground prior to installing poles and pulling it up. Reason for time required, had to be raised but left slack until pulled up by tractor over tops of trees and bushes etc and some trees it has to clear is 40-50 ft high and had to be brought over tops of them so when it would be pulled up it will swing about 50 ft over tops of them. If I get it up this week, hope to finish up on Africa and China this year. Over 1/2 mile copper wire used for each wave on it. Only 2 NRC DXes hrd & reported this season, WWNY-WMRP. Both well rec. Before new Beverage in service WUMS will be testing on if doe directivity(2004 kcs-1/2 watt) a few evenings(Oct 29-Nov 6 between 7-8 PM only. Anyone should get WUMS if in beam.

BOB BOIZUM-READING PA Was up for WJNY test and club DX Wed AM, DXed from 1:45-3:15 then got tired sitting at radio, so shut set off and sat at front window, hoping to wait for 4AM. Fell asleep and got awake when mailmen came around at 8:10 AM. However did hear WJNY same evening from 5:45 to 6:15PM so sent report and thanked them for club special. I read in a Phila paper Friday where a court case is holding up sale of WPEN on 950 kcs. Understand the Philadelphia Evening Bulletin paper will buy WPEN and move station to their own building. No doubt that will mean new call letters. I hope they do sell WPEN as they sure have a lot of foreign programs all day long here and a new call will be welcome with open arms.

EDGAR A KOOP-RODNEY MICH I did some DXing in 39 but didnt verify or know what DXing was then. I started by listening to the radio when I stayed up all night, hrd a station asking for reports so wrote them and they sent me a card (thats all it meant to me then) but now its different. My first verie card was from KCRC in Enid, Okla. Got 2 cards signed by different persons. Then in 1942 I won an album of records from KTSW for being one of the farthest reporters on that certain broadcast, and last winter I did a little more DXing but not as much as I would have liked to.
