The morning of Mar 5th was a swell morning. Have been sending Marsh the signers and hope they will. be a help to others. Veries are coming in slow but there was one week in Feb received 3 in one day and it averaged one a day for that week and from then on one or two a week. Keceived fine letter from WPRA, signed by A Cauraro, Pre and he stetes in his letter that my report is the first they have recoived from as far as Iowa, also received a fine letter from WKAQ signed by E J Dorrel, Vice Pres and he also states in his letter that I was the furthest west to have heard their station.
