April 7 1945 _ _ _ TIPS_and_LPO_REPORTS_ C E SLEICHTER-DEL PASO HGTS, CALIF A verie in from KFQD, really did not expect one for when they were on 1230 I reported twice and never did get a reply. The same with KGBU and never have heard KTKN well enough to report. Weather not good for anything, seems odd to have 70 degree weather as reported by some of the boys, that is at least 8 deg higher than here, as I remember when I leved in Ohio that meant bad weather in April. 3/22 KVOS testing on 790 kc and I can assure you KIEV aid not DX, did not know abt KWKW in time. Have them verified and have only heard them once. KARM shuts them out and am sure they go off about 11 PM EWT. KMYR s/off 3:30; KMYC at 3:15; KWIL at 3AM, that is an extension time for them; CKNW at 3:05AM Maybe KFBK hot off now as they were on all 3/23; KTRB till 4AM Sun AMs; 3/26 XEBZ at 12:15 was R 4-5; CMBF at 12:20 was r-4; CMC kill CFCN at 12:30 and are R-6 and CMCY used KHQ very badly. Have been getting CFJC recent & KSEI, which usually have no chance. KOY s/off at lAM SUN Ams and that does more damage here. At times I hear one on 1230 kcs after 3AM but cannot get call letters, not very strong, wonder who it could be? KHBC tries to get thru KGFJ, doesnt do very well. CKNW only one who does the stunt and R 7-8 every night. Letters to Nichols-Maley-Kruse and Howard who lives quite close to my home town. We always called it Wapok, name too long to say all of it and in those days was a dedided German town. Well we had a very good DX season altho I did not get many in the East, but from 9/21/44 to date got 30 new stations, so am not kicking, they were 2 Aussies; 1 S.A.; 1 Chinesse-3 Cubans in the bunch, on the watch for new 50 KW in Saipan and will get it if on my hours, but WXLD on 660 will be too tough. Considering I had to end the DX season rather early, its been a pretty good year. Best catches were KGLU-KEUB-KTYW-KWJJ-KLBM-CFRN-KJBS-KAVE-WAGM-KORE-KTMS-KEVR-CBR-KONP-CBH-CFGP-KGIR-KID-KWKW. Most have verified but the delinquent are expected such as WAGM-KONP etc. Some of new stations verified include WELO-WHOT-WRLD-KTYW-WMOH-WKLA-KVOP-CKEY-WJEF-KODY-WMLT-CBH and those still out are KONP-KNOE-WHKK-WRHI, Due to the very warm weather here the last 2 weeks I didnt reach the 400 verified mark. Nice verie cards in from CBH-KID-KROY a dup with reports out to KABC-KWKW-WCAZ-WRHI-WHKK. Still looking for verie from KONP, last veries received here were from KVOP-CFGP-CBH. All received same day. Also all for new catches for me. Sure hope some of other reports are verified. Have most of my garden planted and believe it or not have had lettuce from my garden. Hope we do not have a cold spell that would kill the fruit.
