Compiling them all it can be said that as a whole the stations do welcome reports. They all however say that definite proof of reception should be sent including the titles of songs, stetion announcements including the cal.1. they elso sey they like to receive info on quality-fading-static-interforohce and by whom along with other information that will be of some vajue to the station. Signal strongth should al.so be included, a truthful. report and not exagerated just in order to impress them. The correct time was also stressed, especially when sel.ections wore playod and announcements were made. Weather and temp should also be included and if you have a barometer, its roading should be included. So from the above include al.]. usefull informetion but keep it in order so as to make it easy for the station to pick out what they believe is most usefull to them. A neat roport with good information will. most likely be answered more quickly than one that is al.1 messed up and conteins nothing.

It has becn noticed that more and more stations are not answering as they heve in the past. This may be blamed on the shortage of holp and it may al.so be that they do not carc for reports. However there is nothing much wo cen do about it except to be sure that when we do report it wijl. be a good ono and it might be a help in some way to start the veries coming from these slow verifying stetions. The shortage of help is no doubt the cause of many of the stations not enswering as promptly as they did, but it is believed that some of the stetions might be using this as an excuse for not answering at all. Let us hope that in this letter case there are not too many stations. As to WaGii, Dick Cooper has sent the verie cards cnd your verifications will be coming along shortly.
