- WBIZ - Eau Claire, Wisconsin.** Here is a brand new station on 1400 kilocycles, which is usually clear these days, and thus we all will have a chance to add WBIZ to our DX logs. This is a regular test period of WBIZ, and they agreed to dedicate this check to us over the telephone when Sully Sullivan heard them and their Minneapolis monitor didn't. - WLOA - Bradock, Pennsylvania.** Pittsburgh on Parade morning opens with this new station's program. WLOA had a tremendous signal during their preliminary tests last summer, and should do much better during the winter with conditions packing. This past week has been poor for early-AM DXing in this area with Friday being the only half-way decent one. I've twice had unique experiences of hearing double and resultantly, logging both of the WRGA's and WDNC's with different programs at same time, on their old and new frequencies, respectively.
