On 1450, WISNE in one that signe on now at 5:00, while on 2407 , 1 DOS \& KELM, besides WALE, do 1 k kewis. 1490 sees WCUM, WTOR, WHAV, WINR \& WOLF on at-640e E.D.S.T. week-days.
