We are indood very sorry that tho A.R.O. could no longer contimus after a successful showing since its arigin but we wiah to tales thie opportunity to welcome the former A.R.C. meabere as membere of the National Radio Club, With all the privileges of original k.R.C. membera. We certainly hope that we can ploase then with our offorts. The nerger becomes effective this weik and benceforth formar A.H.C, members will receive our bulletine," A awell letter of verification was raceivad from CVIE, "Radio Encrucijada Cuba," 250 watte, $1090 \mathrm{Kc} / \mathrm{s}$. This station was conatructed ky the $21-y$ ear-old son of the owner, and his pictare was encloged.  IX, IS YOUR_DMI WOEMY?
Well, in one sense, all dials are wormy - they have two ends. Well, that may be a poor pun, wo'll grant, but it is one thing some DXars forget at times. Many a good catch on the low end of the basd has been missed, only because the dialist stayed on the high end all morninge. One can never tell at what time a rarely-heard station, like wisem or KGFX, or other daytime stations, might come on the air for a frequency check, or a test. When DX is good, it is entirely possible that the Hawsiians and Alaskans might be heard on the low end of your dial - try every morning for them - there may be onlir one or two mornings when these will come in for you, so don't let it pass, un-noticel. Our suggestion is to make a tour of the dial, from 540 to 1600 , at least every quarterhour, while you are DXing, and make sure you are not missing something you have wanted for a long while. May be a now tester is holding forth on one of the low channels maybe thers's a short tone teat or fraquency chack going on down there! Tune down from time to time, then, while you are at the dials, lest you bow be left out in the coid when some one else is catching a redhot rare station! There are many high-powered Europeans on the low ond, too, and they should be heard till 3 a.m. E.S.T. on good mornings for DX. Don't pass it up! Have a look, and a listen, and add a corking good catch from time to time! NEXT WEEK - ALI NIGHT RENEDIES.
