International Reply Coupene, on sale at your Post office for 114 , are exchangable in South and Cettral American nations for postage of their country, and of coures, also in the West Irdies. On DX programs I alway s report as mach of the programe as can be heard, most tires the entire time they are on the air. I feel that if a station comes on with a DX progran they are at least ontitied to a long report to repay them partly for the time and expense they donate. This of course pertains to real DX prograne and not just the regular 15 or 20 mimate frequency chock. Fell that's all and keep thoae reports coning to both editors, it only takes a fow mimites oach weak and lat the others know what you are hearing.
