On 16th, closed DX season by adding KEYY on f/c. During season reported to 142 new stations, of which at present time all are verified with exception of KSPA & KVON in Clifornia, KSWO in Oklahoma, & KENM KIPA KGIB KIHO KOSE KDEC KOPO WFEC WPCF & WWWW. Just today, 8/19, am again following up KENM KSWO KVON & KSPA. Balance will try to log again sometime. Confined past season mostly to K calls. A few W calls were reported and now verified, namely WSPC WATM WTOR WROD WIKC WIBR WMTW WTXL WEUR WRJW WNAT WKOZ WAPF WABG WUSJ WFRO. Not too many new Canadians but all were very welcome. All now verified there were CHFA CJDC CKOY & CJNB. Only foreign veries outside of Puerto Rico was 172. Sent my report aim ail and enclosed IRC. Came back in just a month.
