During the past several weeks your publisher has received a few letters deploring the use of stapled bulletins and requesting a return to the use of envelopes. At least 2 members have sent in an extra dollar with their dues to pay to have their bulletins sent in onvelopes!

So, I thought it would be best to ask for you members to write me and let me know what you think best. Fere are the figures. The use of staples instead of envelopes saves the club approximately $\$ 15$ per year and this sevings is based on the cost of the last envelopes purchased in September, 1949. They have probably gone up since then. Just what this will mean in the cost of a membership I will not know until I start to purchase our years supplios again next summer.

I would also like to point out that we havo had trouble using the addresser on the stapled bulletins and the use of envelopes might be forced on us for that reason alone, however, more on that later. I'm still experimenting on that end.

You might be rolioved to leam that bulletins sent to prospective members, DXing stations, eto. are all sont in onvolopes.
