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Twenty years ago this date $\bar{I}$ sent my first long wave reception report to WRL for reception at 1:45 AM. on Sunday AM Dec. 28, 1930. A few days later I received my first verification although prior to that I have received some shortwave verifiotions. In looking over the verifications I have received during the past 20 years perhaps the following are the 20 best or at least the 20 I enjoyed getting the most: HIX, DX Mar. 1932; KGMB, Oct. 1932; 10-BI (25 w.) Jan. 1933; KFPM (15w.) DX Jan. 1933; 2YA Mar. 1933; HHK, Sept. 1933; VE9EK (10 w.) DX Nov. 1933; CP4, DX Mar. 1934; 4BH, Oct. 1934; VOGY, DX Oct. 1934; IITR Jan. 1935; VAS Jan. 1935; $10-\mathrm{BP}$ ( $25 \mathrm{w} . \&$ CKNX 50 w .) April 1935; CP-52, Nov. 1935; ZBM, Dec. 1946; VOCM, Dec. 1946; KFAR, Jan. 1947; HCJB-DX Feb 1948 ; CW-45-A DX Mar. 1948; ACA, DX Oct. 1950. On Sept. I I needed 60 more heard to reach 2000 by the end of 1950 and I was pleased to be able to list CX-28 as the 2000 t . station heard. Verifications stand at 1314 as there are many I do not write to. My best $D X$ this fall has been ACA, CB-106, verified with folded card \& small pennant. TIFC, $995 \mathrm{kc} / \mathrm{s} /$, of ten heard early evenings when South is good.
