I have about 12 of the old stations and 8 from post-war DX troadossts to fill up both sides of a $10 \mathrm{minch} r e c o r d$ cut at $78 \mathrm{IR}, \mathrm{P} . \mathrm{M}$. It makes a rether interesting record for a DXer to listed to and a few of those selected are KYW Chieago, fust before move to Philadelphia; CFLC, Prescott, Ont., CMPN, Havana, KPRM, Greonville: Texas, and the announcer spells out F-I-F-T-E-E-N. watts. CHGS in Surmerside gny the last day for WSAL, Salisbury, Mid., put off the air by F.C.C. Narch 30, 1940. More recant DX anmouncements include HHGM CKCL KCRG. Of course there's lots of noise as those old alminum records were not noted for quality and there is the evor-present static. Since I can make duplicates of the composite record that I made for myself, I thourht maybe some others that have turntables might like a copy.
