From the NZDXRI we leam that the Australian Broadeasting Control Board has fumished a peport to the Federal Parliament of plans to Increase the efficiency of $A B C$ and commercial stations. It provided for 20 new ABC stations throughout Australia, increased power for 27 existing ABC stations, and power incroasos to 2000 w for 56 B stations. But it is a long-term policy. 3BN, Bendigo, on which work has al ready bogun, will not be in operation until 1953-54. The new ABC stations will bo mainly 200-wattors. Several of the commission's city outlots are to go from 10 Kw to 50 Kw , the Victorien schedule being 3 LO and 3 AR to 50 Kw . in 1958 , 3WV to $50 \mathrm{Kw} \mathrm{1959}, \mathrm{3GI} \mathrm{to} 10 \mathrm{Kw} \mathrm{1959}$. indication has boen givon of when the NZBS will bo in a pooltion to follow through. Looks as if Australia plans to bring its broadcasting up to the general limits of American broadcasting in the USA.
