No DX activity here so I'll just review last season's results a lítile. Only tro veries received during Juno came from CMKP (670) of the Radio Progreso networie and a self-prepared International Roply Card from TICS (855) "La Voz de Americal for reception of last Nov. 13. These two rephesent my final entries in the contest. Maybe they'll be sufficient (if goy Millar's mailman forgot his address, hi). The prepared card for TICS was signed and rubber-stampd by the Gerente but signature is illegible. This gives me a total of 136 veries for the season with 51 foreign in 17 countries. Though my main attention was foreign DX, I did verify 35 states and thre provinces. Still unanewered are 71 reports of which 51 are foreign. So on foreign reports I have just a $50 \%$ return, of course, of those unanswered, 21 are Mexican and nine Cuban, six Colombia, four Venezuela, two each in Dominiman Fepublic, El Salvadord, and Japan. So much for the veries! Total heard log is 674 in 42 states, five provinces and 25 foreign countries (total foreign, 231). Even though I didn't get started until late in the season, I feel that I have had a most successful season not only from the standpoint of veries and statistics, but for the good wholesome enjoy ent and relaxation in the time spent in this fine hobby of ours Also for knowing euch a fine fellow as Hank Jilkinson, and meeting our other Los Angeles area dial-twisters, Ted, Mort, John Boase, John Alexander, and Bob Morris. Hope to moet them all again(and more, too) at the big NRC get-together at Kank's on July 21 when old-timer Joe Lippencott will be visiting from the East.

The OCs evae-rode the noise, and I was able to take a good log on KBYR. I've never hear' them since. And I've heard Roy's tape of an Itdiana station on 1230 he managed to hear, rather, and Illinois station, who did DX same nicht as KRXK. The Illinois station was schoduled to close DX at same time KRXK started theirs. The frequency was virtually a blank until two minutes before and of IIlinois DX.
