## RIDIO STATTONS AND DX

( 1 EDITORIIT - by PHIL POTTER)
All of us DXers like to feel that our hoboy is wortn'while, important and useful, as well as fu:1. And it is, but for different reasons than some DXers seem to think. I have beer in the cormercial radio business for 11 years and have worked and talked with scores of engineers and program people, who usually receive DX mail. iloes nonreplies to DX nail result when witing to the smaller stations (some exceptions, of course.) Mhis is usualiy becase mail is handled in a casual mamer, with DX replies going to an amouncer, the office girl, or to an engineer. All of these people are very busy yith their duties trying to make money for their station. They amounce, write comercials, file records, fix equipment, etc. all day and are not looking for extra work. Unless they are interested in DX themselves (as I am) the reports mean little to them, frankly. Some don't even know what they are. (I remember one station that "ratified" rather than "verified" a report.) Now, why aren't DK reports really important? The answer is that the only covergge a station is interested in is its ground wave signal ard the commercial potential it serves. Skip distance reception is vareliable and means nothins as far asp a station is concerned. Niso, before a stction coes on the air, its coverage is sccurately computed by radio engineers for submission to the F.C.C. before a grant is made. The coverage is checked after they are on the air, and coverage maps are made for distribution to sponsors. That is the only coverage that has maning to a station, excppt for specific individuals who are interested in DX." Here are my suggostions: "Trite a friendly, easy to read letter stressing the fact you will appreciate their takirg a moment to reply. I personnaly would sem the letter to the manager of the station. He is often more concerned with audienee mail than others. Enclose return postace. Tell how happy you were to hear the progrom and how fine you thought it sounded, and a prepared card will likely get petter results. Letis face it, the stations are doing us a favor in replying. List local names, commercials, etc. Do not bother loging music titles (except on DX shows) or recapping a newscast. Practicallypno stations keep that detailed a record of what went on the air. I am not debunking DYing itl's great, end I love it, but if you want replies, face the fact that you are asking the courtesy of a reply.
