The spots on the dial are $3330 \mathrm{kc} / \mathrm{s} ., 7335$ and 14670 . As you can see, these are in the 5 fit bards. The most popular and powerful is the $7335 \mathrm{kc} / \mathrm{s}$. This frequency is just above the 40 meter "ham" phone band. Just tune through the $C$ and phone portions of the band and there you are - you can't miss the beat signal they transmit. The stations give the time in voice every minute between the 51 st and 59 th seconds. The seconds' beats of the first minute of each hour are replaced by the inorse Code "CHU Canada CHU" repeated tilice. Oh yes, for those who ve uld like to ads another v/c, this station does verie.
