

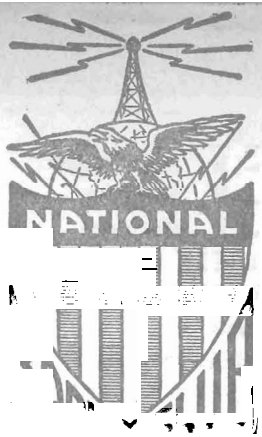

Mystery: Who is the Canadian (?) on 740 that s/off (?) (heard GSQ) at 5:29 on 2/18, Sunday, behind WMBL and other ARM? To Edwin S. Jr., to quote from Navships 93221 page 1-8: "The most serious result of selective fading, and the most common, occurs when the carrier level is attenuated more than the sidebands. When this occurs the carrier voltage at the receiver is less than the sum of the two sideband voltages. When the carrier is attenuated more than the sidebands, the RF envelope does not retain its original shape, and distortion is extremely severe upon demodulation. This distortion results upon demodulation because a carrier voltage at least as strong as the sum of the two sideband voltages is required to properly demodulate the signal. The distortion resulting from a weak carrier can be overcome by use of the exalted carrier technique whereby the carrier is amplified separately and then reinserted before demodulation. In using the exalted carrier, the carrier must be reinserted ~~xxxxxxx~~ close to the original phase of the AM carrier." That last sentence is important. You seem to be supplying an external RF carrier into the IF stages with your oscillations. This is also done by an OC on the same frequency. But if the phase is wrong, this won't work. - 950 LR3 Buenos Aires, Argentina, "Radio Belgrano", in around S-6 on 2/5 at 0415, so reported as didn't verify for me previously. (FHN)
- 975 TIRS San Jose, Costa Rica, conjecture here as slogan seemed to be "Radio Mitros" and not "Radio Athona". Fair S-4 2/12 from 0636-0645 and on. ~~See~~ Who knows? (PT)
- 990 XECL Mexicali, B. Cfa., probably the tester here 2/11 0630-0645 and on. Some US and LA music un-IDing, but quite distorted. (PT)
- 1000 ..... Peking, China, 2nd report 2/7 0532-0600 up to S-5. This is the first time I have heard their programming (music) overlap the time pips. (PT)  
I2D Tauranga, New Zealand, had inconsistent signal 2/12 compared with IYC. They are usually the strongest from New Zealand. (DBM)
- 1003 ..... LA here with S-5/6 signal on 2/20 from 2220-2230; continuous newsreel type program, and think it was "Radio Noticias", YNHTM, Managua, not positive. Was not a Cuban, nor was it TICCN, see 1005 Kcs. (BD)
- 1005 TICCN San Ramon, Costa Rica, still seems to be using this freq.; at least they were on 2/20 between 2200 and 2220, S-7/8 signals and frequent mention of "Radio Cima". Have they been heard on 1000 Kcs.? (BD)
- 1007 ..... LA noted here 0650 2/12. Maybe Ashby's TICCN in 2/3 issue. Weak. (PT)

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- 1040 JO.. Hokkaido, Japan. This graveyard readable 0300-0900 2/11, easy copy for a solid hour 0300-0400, several time sigs on tape, up to S-6. No call letters given on breaks. Will let NHK decipher this one, via tape. Hokkaido mentioned on each break. (PT)
- 1043 .... South Korean here 2/11 0830-0850, probably the one listed for 1045. Report sent. (PT)
- 1052 BBC BBC Home Service is not in parallel with BEC on 1214. 1214 transmits Light Program with music and entertaining programs (BAE)
- 1070 CBA Good signal at 0030 on 1/21. (RP)(GMT)
- 1090 KHAI Honolulu, Hawaii, logged for first time on 2/5 0443-0500 s/off with frequent IDs as "Radio in Focus-KHAI-Honolulu". Steady S-5 signal. (FHN) Excellent on 1/8, 20 db over S-9 at times from 0400 to after 0445. (DBM)
- 1100 HJAT Barranquilla, Colombia, apparently is here now, "Radio Reloj" ID heard and someone, maybe HJCN, heard on 2/12 after 0400 also with "Radio Reloj" ID on 1105 Kcs. (DBM)
- 1105 HJ-- Colombian on 2/20 announcing as "Radio Reloj", S-6/7 signal 2300-2330. Can't say which station, though, as WRH shows both Barranquilla and Bogota as having a "Radio Reloj" station on 1100 Kcs. (BD)
- 1095\* OAX2B "Radio Trujillo", Trujillo, Peru, heard here in Sweden using this frequency. Quite good once. (BAE)
- 1110 YVNN Punto Fijo, Venezuela, verified by PP card signed and rubber stamped "Radio Punto Fijo", "Radio Nacional Rumbos", gave schedule as 0600-Midnight, Venezuela time. (SRM)

- 1187 .... "Radio Maroc", Rabat, uses this frequency for mostly Spanish speaking programs after 1700 EST, but sometimes they use French. (BAE)

- 1365 S... SS here on 2/5 with political talk, believe to be Costa Rica
- 1385 .... ID of station here still unknown. Had concert music on 2/21 from 2135-s/off at 2203. Can't seem to catch any voice, but

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suspect 4VS as other Haiti were heard that evening. WRH says Radio Hoyer 3 (PJB-2) in NWI signs off at 2030. (BD)

- 1428 .... British Forces Broadcasting Station in Valetta on Malta heard here some nights with a test program. Weak signals. Quite new. Heard at 2000. (BAE)
- 1475 .... Vienna I was S-8 at s/on on 2/23. Broadcast interval signal from 2327 to 2330 followed by regular s/on announcement. Signal did not linger long. (BD)
- 1480 JORF Yokohama, Japan, "Radio Kanto" verified reception of 12/19 on 3 different QSL cards with several nice stamps on the envelope. (RHM)
- 1500 AFRTS A new AFRTS station heard here. It is not Lages Field, Azores, as they s/off at 2100. At 2130 on 2/14 this new one heard. It wasn't Asmara, Eritrea. Probably somewhere in Africa. Likely Wheelus Field, Libya, but no definite ID heard. (BAE)
- .... "Radio Martinique" well heard here on 2/14 signing off at 2140. News at 2130. (BAE) / (RP)
- .... "Radio Atlantico", Canary Islands, in Spanish at 2330 GMT.
- 1505 TIRU Liberia, Costa Rica, verio by air mail for 2/5 report x signed by Jose Luis Jimenez A., administrador. Stationery still shows 1500 Kcs. address TIRU, Union Comercial Ltda. Liberia, Guarnasasto, Costa Rica. (Aptdo 25). Logged on AN 2/5 for elections. (SRM) Also reported in parallel with TIRICA (625) as mystery. (PT)(Peto, this is definitely TIRU-FV) Reported as unID SS on 2/5 with political talk. (FHN)(TIRU) This is probably the heterodyne reported by DBM on here also.
- 1510 WMEX Good signal at 0010 GMT. (RP)
- 1520 HJFV "La Voz del Litoral", Barranquilla, Colombia, heard well 2/10 with ID 2200. (BAE) / (SRM)
- .... UNID SS with semi-classics 2/5 0330 equal to KOMA at times.
- 1533 HJOL Bogota, logged for first time on 2/4 2142-2200 with good signal at times. (FHN) Who for sure was the Colombian AN here on 12/25/61? (DBM)(Looks like HJOL-FV) Spanish speaking LA at about this spot s/off at 2340 on 2/20, and I wonder if it was the new HJFC in Bogota, mentioned in last week's DIGEST. (BD)(Who knows, HJOL or HJFC?-FV)
