WKBA-1550, Office of the Chief Engineer, Route 7, Box 300-C, Roanoke, Virginia.

Dear Mr. Cooper:

(in part)

March 9, 1962

"WKBA began regular programming on October 13, 1961. I am sorry to say that the Chief Engineer during construction did not verify any reports. This man is Chief Engineer of a station in Lynchburg, Virginia, and I imagine you have trouble getting any verifications from there also. Since commencing my duties at WKBA, I am endeavoring to rectify this situation, therefore my apologies are in order for the earlier situation. "The fact that you are Editor of the NRC is quite interesting. I am wondering if you might have a sample copy of your bulletin, and some figures on the number and areas of circulation. I am sorry to say that the station management is not whole heartily in favor of DX verifications. I hope that your circulation figures may help me prove that DX letters are a help in estimating a skywave pattern and interference. The station management has seen fit at times to even go to the point of opening the mail and removing the postage. This has necessitated personal outlay. I have done this because I am in sympathy with your requests for verifications, being an amateur, W4ZSM, and ex-SWler.

"If you have some way in your bulletin of advising your associates of the situation in regard to verifications you may wish to furnish them with my office address in order that this mail will reach me directly and untampered.

"I conduct frequency checks bi-monthly from 12:00 midnight to 12:30 a.m. on the third Saturday morning, the last check being February 17, 1962. Following these checks I conduct my regular equipment tests.
