SEVEN (7) SPECIAL TESTS ON THIS WEEK!W K S C - 1300 - Feb. 16, 1:00-4:00 a.m.Mr. Jess B. Tatum, Pres.

"This is to advise that on Feb. 16 at 0100 we will be making experimental tests which will last until approximately 0400. You may like to notify your other DX listening fans. We will make station identifications at least every 15 minutes and our regular schedule program will begin at approximately 0400 Saturday AM," writes Mr. Tatum. We believe only WERE & KOL will be on 1300 at the time so be sure to try for this station, which first saw the light of day on 12/21/61. S/on 4am Sat., 5am other days. ERC

W D E A - 1370 - Feb. 18, 2:00-3:00 a.m.Mr. Frank Chalmers Jr., CE.

This hour will be filled mostly with test cycle tones, with some music towards the end of the hour, for program level adjustments. At times, the carrier might go off for brief moments as they conduct this equipment test. WDEA stands for "Wonderful Down East Area" and formerly operated on 1350 with 1,000 watts. Only KEEN should be on this channel during this time, so most of us should log their 5,000 non-directional watts handily. We are grateful to Mr. Chalmers for letting us know of his test. LEN KRUSE

W P T W - 1570 - Piqua, O., 2/18, 3:30-4:00.Mr. John E. Morris, Eng.Dot

WPTW will be making a special test at this time, consisting of music and IDs, and some cycle tone at times. This station is very very seldom on the air during the experimental period so we caution you not to miss tuning for this test. CKIM will be on, and we are not sure whether XERF will be or not. WPTW, though, is non-directional, and we have high hopes their signal will get out well. Our thanks to Mr. Morris for clueing us in on this test, and send your reports to him, at WPTW. MARV ROBBINS

K X E X - 1550 - Feb. 18, 3:30-4:00 EST.Mr. Harold O. Torosian, CE.

This test is probably to go on on this date; however, if any problems arise there, the test will be made one week later, same time, on Feb. 25th. A new station, KXEX took to the air last Sept. 20th. Their normal programming is entirely in Spanish, but we believe they will stick to English during their test period. This channel is expected to be completely clear. They use a Bauer transmitter, and have a 368' non-directional tower, which means they ought to get out very well. LEN KRUSE

C B 7 3 - 730 - Valparaiso, Chile, Feb. 18, 4-4:30 EST. Sr. Roberto Reyes Barrueto, G.

Many of you will recall that this station put on a DX show for us last year, but at that time Station HJCU was also on, and they made it particularly rough copy for CB-73. HJCU is no long on 730, so this time we should have a much better shot at CB73. There will be English as well as Spanish announcements, and probably Chilean musical selections. With 10,000 watts, this will give you a great chance of adding Chile to your country lists, so give this station a really good try! DAVID E. ROYS

W S G O - 1440 - Feb. 18 - 4:00-4:30 a.m.Mr. Clifford C. Harris, GM;CM

This station is not quite one year old, having started on 3/9/62, so few DXers have heard it. We have learned of this test, and the 1440 spot is supposed to be completely clear, coast to coast, and so their thousand watts should really sail. We do not know what WSGO will have on the air during this half-hour test, but it'll probably be music, tones, and plenty of IDs. Mr. Clifford C. Harris is General & Commercial Manager, and owns the station, and Mr. R. K. Harris is C.E. We hope everyone hears them! LEN KRUSE

W T H M - 1530 - Lapeer, Mich., 2/18, 4:30-5.Mr. Douglas Geisenhaver, C.E.

Another clear channel is envisioned as WTHM conducts their first test since going on regular schedule in November, 1962. They have been heard quite extensively in the N.E. at twilight time, and in the early morning. We do not know the material to be aired as they make this equipment test, but again, it should be records and tones, with station breaks very frequent. Before I give my regular report I thought you might want to print up this special info about s/on & s/off of all daytime stations. The times are (s/on, a.m.; s/off, p.m.) Jan. 7:15-5:00. Feb. 6:45-5:30. Mar. 6:15-6:00. Apr. 5:30-6:30. May 4:45-7:00. Jun 4:30-7:30. July- 4:45-7:30. Aug.- 5:15-7:00. Sept. 5:45-6:15. Oct.- 6:15-5:15. Nov 6:45-4:45. Dec.- 7:15-4:30. Some stations vary about 15 minutes either way but not too many. An example of this would be WPGC Md. They s/off in Jan. at 5:15 instead of 5pm. Also don't forget that these times are one hour later when using DST. This info is from WNJH who uses the exact sked as above. (This is not it, Dave - every city is figured separately. S/on time & s/off time are the nearest even 15-minute period to average sunrise or sunset each month. For example, there is one hour & 15 minutes' difference in Dec. in s/off's for WNEP-1470 in Mass. & WPAP-1570 in Fla! -ERC) I have not been DXing much in the past few weeks due to General Exams coming up.
