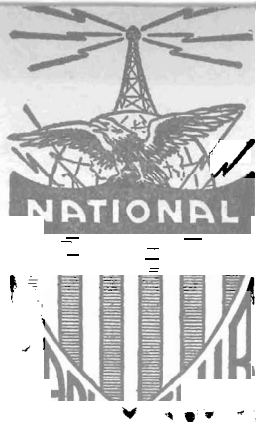

WYNR-1390 ex-WGES is still getting into trouble. The complaints stem mainly around their contests which, it has been alleged, have "caused or threatened to cause substantial damage to public & private property in Chicago." Another contest "led members of the public to telephone certain persons" causing them "Harassment." A third contest "led to a disturbance in a Chicago public high school/" A secondary point was the abandonment of foreign language broadcasts which had been a long-standing policy of the old WGES. Points still at 218 since can't count a station verie twice even though heard twice, different v/l for different date, different CX. 73s.

Latest veries are v/l's from WHOA San Juan & KQYX Joplin, Mo. & v/cs from WKNX-test & WCLE, Cleveland, Tenn., the latter one of the most colorful & attractive I've seen.

Best DX of the year: KFBK-1530; KKHI-1550 CJCA-930 CFAC-960 KOGO-660 KDWB-630; ZNS-1540 KRAK-1140 KAKC-970 KMOR-1510 KFRO-DX-1370 KSUM-test-1370 KMLB-1440; KCBS-740 CFCN-1060 KSSS#740 WAVA-test-780 WINX-1600 KSOO-1140 CKCK-620 KWRE-730 CJOC-1220 KOLY-1300 WKAT-1360 WWDC-1260 KMHL-1400 KPRO-1440 WJAS-1320 & KRIG-1410. Sheldon Miller - 1216 Pennsylvania Avenue - Miami Beach 39, Florida

This is my first Musing since joining NRC last month. I have been DXing for a little over a year. Before I found out about the NRC I thought I was the world's lone DXer! I use the Hallicrafters S-120 RX, which is a LEMON on ECB. The selectivity is awful & local stations hog up from 40 to 100 kc/s. on the dial! This makes it pretty difficult to DX with all the AN stations here in Miami. Split frequencies are impossible except for the very loudest ones. I have a total of 497 stations heard, from 28 countries & 34 states. This was accomplished only by using many different radios, antenna systems, loop, etc. I have averaged over three new stations daily during the first two months of this year, but I doubt I can maintain this average for long. This morning I got up early & logged some great catches: KIMN-950 KLCN-910 WKY-930 KQEO-920 & my best LA DX, LR3-950 which came through completely in the clear for about 20 minutes with NX & WX in SS, many clear IDs & even gave calls. Try them if you need Argentina. By the way, the SS many of you guys are hearing on 1140 may be WMIE here in Miami. They use 10kw. & are in SS all night with hourly announcements in EE. (At least they have been for the last few eeks.) In closin let me say that I would welcome hearing from anyone who knows a way to improve my selectivity, or who wants to write about anything else. Also I have plenty of WOAM-560 surveys free-free-free to anyone who wants them, as I have enough of that station as it is! Everyone listen for my voice over CKY-580. They must have liked my report as they call the other night & had me do a promotional announcement for them! I guess that's the first time a DXer ever verified a station, instead of viss-versa. 73.
