May I have a word about Omaha '59? There were two concrete publishing offers ready for presentation at the Convention then - mine, & Stan Morss'. There were major flaws in each, which neither of us kept secret. The major flaw in my offer was a possible deadline advance or change in editors due to distance from editor to publisher. The major flaw in Stan's offer was that he would have to hold off publishing for a six-to-eight week period in the Spring due to press of his occupational duties. The third offer, not presented in person, was of the unknown quality. With these flaws in mind, Len Kruse & Bob Gorsuch, the night before the Omaha Business Meeting, visited Pop & Kate Edge to talk Pop into publishing. Pop agreed, providing the government was established as it is now & providing he be allowed to continue his six-week vacation. When Stan & I became aware of Pop's decision, we withdrew our offers, & they were never formally presented to the Coub for a vote. The day after the business session, at motel poolside, I offered Amarillo's services to Pop, since he had that six week vacation, & since some members might have been worried due to the bulletin delay. The mimeo machine I had counted on in Canyon, however, was in a sad state of repair & unusable. The second mimeo machine in Hereford also was no good. Finally, Larry Godwin took the remaining stencils to a commercial mimeographer & printed them (as I understand it, out of his own pocket). Jeff Stewart, Neil Eubanks & Glen Kippel, in 1961, offered to publish one issue for two reasons: 1) Ray had another long Western vacation, & 2) They wanted to recoup Amarillo's good name after the 1959 fiasco. Again, the mimeo problems, as shown in Jeff's "reminiscence." No one, I'm sure, underestimates the work & difficulties that go into the bulletin. I would like to have the above on the record, however, because (though I am certain this was not the intent of recent literature from HQ), many may consider Jeff Stewart, John Tudenham, Neil Eubanks & myself "discredited" by this literature.
