Perfect EE and signed by Jose A. Ribas Mgr. Take not Hank W. and others, in case you have trouble. Caroline North & South both veried now. North's address is P.O. Box 3, Isle of Man, and Mike Marriott, DJ, sent long typed letter & a beautiful QSL w/picture of the MV Caroline. Has unipole 168' high and makes it 180' above sea level. Mike is a Dartmouth graduate and knows our local University (UVM) very well, also Burlington. Caroline South had form letter w/initials of QSL manager. 1495 outlet is off Haswich, England, unipole is 142' high. They have had hum which muffles speech and their rr is rough. I can't tell one number from another. Use advertising if possible - I finally did. "Radio Veronica" out since 1/64, finally got a real good reception & got one of their "promising" letters for QSL in future. Let's hope it arrives. CKIM makes Veronica plenty tough here. 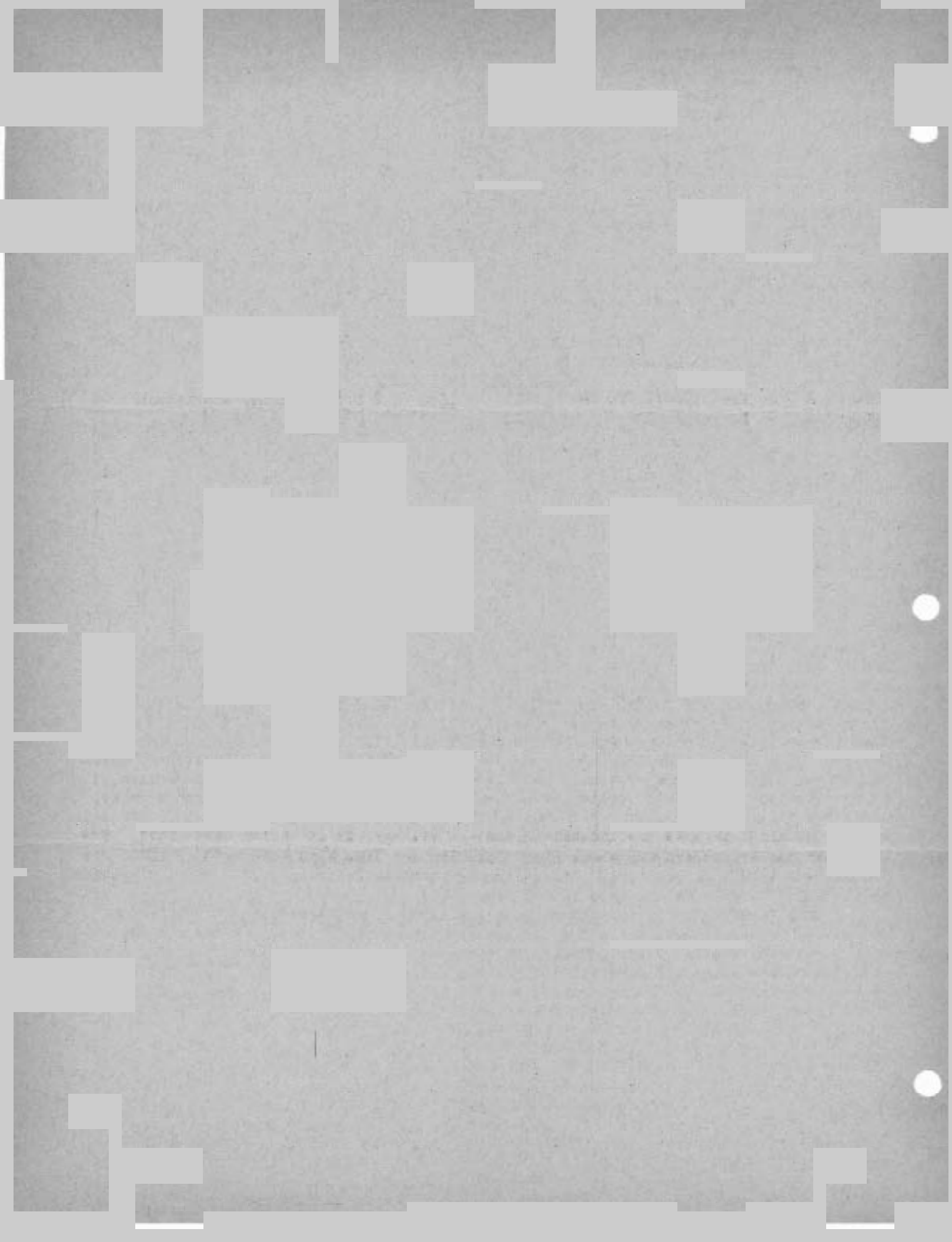
