Therefore, no MM DX. A message for image-haunted DXers. To tell an image from a true signal, note the ~~diff~~ heterodynes produced by the signal against a known true signal. Now tune up or down, it makes no difference which. If the het whistle shifts in frequency as you tune, then the signal in question IS an image. If it does not, then it IS NOT an image. Since my old RX had no RF amplifier stage, it was rather imagy. The Philco 650 now used has one RF stage; it is free from image interference. That, at least, is one problem I do NOT have. One question for Gordon Nelson: Gordon, how do you manage to understand the languages used on these fantastic split frequencies of yours? In order to eliminate the het from a few kilocycles away, I have to turn selectivity up to the point where I can no longer understand even EE, let alone others. How DO you do it? 73, all.

Absolute sense measurements showed it was coming from the reciprocal direction; after some interesting technical detective work it turned out to be a suprious emission from CBL, Toronto. Also I get OC on lower sideband, I suspect a parasitic in modulator. I recently talked to an Israeli who had just come over; says Israeli sked is currently 11 pm-4pm & that BBC Cyprus is poorly heard even in Israel. Now I don't feel so bad. (Maguire, N.M. - ditto Parsons) SCOTLAND. B.B.C. Light program remains easily the best bet for Europe on the West Coast. On 11/12, hit good room filling volume in peaks just before 2100 with instrumental music, but voice much poorer and rapid fades. S/off just past 2100. The "Top of the World" map with the current issue of National Geographic shows clearly why I have to agree with Roy Millar that we in the west at least are hearing the West-erglen transmitter, if only one is involved. - ISLE OF MAN. Manx Radio, Douglas, not audible around 0830 with "Lucky Dip" programme and local commercials. (Patrick, England.)
- 1345 KUWAIT. Continue to hear this one, but not so well as before; am still having a real rough time getting enough characteristic material for a meaningful report. S/on at 2100 on 11/13, with best signal that weak.

- 1348 INTL. WATERS (England). R. Essex. New pirate station, on a PCRT, now testing. (Patrick England)
- 1352.7 INTL. WATERS (England). R. Essex now seems to have turned from tests to regular programming. Address is 33 Avenue Road, Southend on Sea, Essex. Does not operate from Shivering Sands, from the fort "Knock John" instead. (Ryden, Sweden.) Don't think I care for their name of the fort. (Ed.)
- 1457 ENGLAND. B.B.C. West Regional heard here 0135 past 0245 11/15 with news, weather, stock report, mostly documentary programmes - interviews, etc. -- little music. The signal was very strong at times, but there was much deep, prolonged fading. (Parsons, Ontario) **Strong S-9 MM 11/15. (Snyder, N.Y.)**
- 1460 JAPAN. Unid. clear at ID time, but couldn't make it out 11/15 at 0430. Only one Japanese heard. Weak Spanish CRM that seemed off frequency about 100 cycles. (Scrimgeour, Calif.)
- PUERTO RICO. WFBA, San Sebastian. May have been the music-player under KTYM with test 0400-0430 11/22. KTYM sounded like 200 kw., and mike modulation was so bad, I have no wonder they were ET'ing. (Callarman, Texas)
- 1466 MONACO. Monte Carlo very strong S9+10 MM 11/15. Played "Ghost Riders in the Sky" at 0120. (Snyder, N.Y.)
- 1470 JAPAN. NHK-2 relays heard well on 11/15 from 0430 to 0446 parallel to 1370. Japan on most channels between 1410 and 1560 lately, when clear. (Scrimgeour, Calif.)
- 1484 ENGLAND. B.B.C., Barrow/Ramsgate. Very good signal on 11/15, as late as 0350. (Dangerfield, Pa.)
- 1493 INTL. WATERS (England). R. Caroline South fair level 1855 w/U.S. ~~RRR~~ on 11/12; not as good this year as last. (Nelson, Miss.)
- 1516 CHINA. Peking. Very strong broadcasting in Russian. Heard in the afternoons. Wonder if it is in China or in Europe, maybe Albania? (Patrick, England) See below. (Ed.)
- 1525 CHINA. The big news this week is the appearance of a R. Peking transmitter for the all-day Russian service. This station was first heard on 1516 kc. from the beginning of November, but yesterday, 11/13, they changed to 1525 kc. They put in a tremendous signal here, and you can hardly believe the signal comes all the way from China. However, lopp checks indicate that the signals really come from the East. It is probable that they operate with superpower and a highly directional antenna toward Moscow (and Scandinavia.) R. Peking foreign service has been noted here in other languages on 1190, 1210 and 1309.8 kc. Easily identifiable as they play "The Internationale" at the end of the programmes. Also, the well-known interval signal. It appears that R. Peking is taking the practice of using split frequencies (-5 kc. in Asian areas, 1516 and 1525 in the European area) to get through the interference. **I hope this will (not-ed) spread as it will no doubt increase the interference and chaos that already exists.** (Ryden, Sweden)
- 1560 AUSTRALIA, 2RE, Taree, N.S.W. Clear ID and time call of "7 o'clock" at 0400, 11/3. Unneeded, but a thrill to hear! (Millar, Wash.)
