- X 555 Nicaragua. YNS, R. Tic Tac was in and out 11/10; enuf for report and good tape. ID's after every record w/same announcement in SS; keeps plugging 555 kcs onda larga. (Starr, Ohio)
- **600 Saudi Arabia. Riyadh undoubtedly the strong AA speaker hrd around what seems to be s/off time circa 1600; unn. so not too interested here. (Slater, U.K.)
