FLASH TIPS & SUCHLIKE

Firstly, a call from Skip Dabelstein informs us that neither KBEW-1560 nor KPOC-1420 were on. The former because the CE overslept, the latter because he thought it was Monday night instead of Monday morning. Both are re-sked for 1/20/75, only change is that KBEW will be on ½ hour later. Skip noted (and I confirm -RJE) that WPEH-1420 was on for PoP w/strong TTs and IDs from: at least 0200 to at least 0400. Likewise, W3LB-1560 was on w/ late 40's-early 50's mx and many IDs 0230-0300+. KKAA was also on w/ mx, OG, and reverb IDs. WTGA test got only TT to most places, tho' ELK & HWB got IDs. No word yet on other 12/9 TESTS. Also no word on WSLT-1520 for 12/16. Sorry about the late notification (after the fact) of the WHAZ-1330 TEST 12/16. Joe got the info here in time, but I mis-placed it. Tried to get info to Flash, but made no connexions - RJE

- 570 -MEXICO XEBJB Monterrey, N.L. 12/9 1236-1254 w/nortena mx, time and temp, plus call letter jingle after each record. Many spots. Very rough thru domestics. (Gleason)
- 600 -MEXICO (Harmonic) On 1800 khz 12/6 1259, ID w/600 khz, "... (radiazo?) mexicano, una estacion hecha a su gusto". Maybe XEDN, Torreon; also 12/5, not 12/7. (Hauser)
- 610 -MEXICO XEGS Guasave, Sin. 12/9 1254-1300 w/mx without ID up till 1300 s/on, mentioning 1000 watt power and "Canal 61". (Gleason)
- 647 -USSR FES, 11/30 1300 w/bell chimes repeated 5 times, then femme and male ancrs - "Moy paterb quan poten-tie" o/band mx, then just femme ancr to 1328, brief mx at 1320. 1300 bells and slogan repeated 1330; strong. (Vernon)
- 660 -UNID (Alaska?) My 660 unid of last week - after 2 1/2 hours of filtering, finally pulled an ID. Is WBBM Chicago - estimate this spur has about 150 watts or less in it. Dunno how often this exists-maybe only when it snows. (Boyd)
- 700 -JAPAN JOFE/JOKD 12/3, 1320+ NHK2 program "This is NHK, All high school EE program" very faint //750, 770,830,870 all booming in. (Vernon)
- 705 -UNID SS noted 12/9 1146. "Clanco", I suppose. (Hauser)
- 710 -UNID SS nx, AST TCs, 0946 12/9. If WRTH 74 sked info still correct, would be Puerto Rico, not Venezuela. (Hauser) Believe the YV is now AN. (ED)
- 765 -EL SALVADOR YSKL net, 12/9 1142 mx // 770; 1151 ending devotional, TC for 9 to 6; clearer and stronger than 770 outlet. (Hauser)
- 770 -EL SALVADOR YSKL net, 12/9 1142 mx // 765. (Hauser)
- 775 -COSTA RICA La Exitosa, presumably, w/segues, including El Condor Pasa, 12/9 1143; faded completely out a bit later. (Hauser) (Babarovich)
- 830 -JAPAN JOBB Osaka 12/4, 1500 in fair w/pips and man in JJ, then mx o/u KGO. UNID lacking a handy anthem guide, I haven't pinned this one down yet; it's full of fanfares, not HJ or YV, 12/9 1137 into s/on, but losing out to WCCO.
- 854 -PERU R. Nacional del Peru, Lima 12/4 0224 good carrier, then (Hauser) some female vocal mx; 0229 TC for 21:30, chimes, believe mentioned Peru; I can't imagine it being anything else. (Hauser)
- UNID 12/9 0500-0505 w/SS talk at 0500 by man, into a "valse" and then man and YL at 0503. Would wager that I had Lima, but no positive ID heard. Returned at 0507 w/an instrumental of "Sombras" an Ecuadorian song popular in the Andean zone. (Gleason)
- 880 -GUATEMALA? Hard-sell SS sermon; lo het, freq slightly high, 12/9 1153. Or maybe a Mexican on already? (Hauser)
- 885 -MONTSERRAT ZJB Plymouth 12/4 0117 a taped report on United Nations activities in EE; fade before ID; 0224 check, mx. 12/9 0956 choral mx, 0958 0 Little Town of Bethelhem; 1001 "You have been listening to music to start the day", TC for 6:00, ZJB ID. (Hauser)
- 888 -MEXICO? Extremely distorted spur, 12/9 1123 SS, CST, believe Zaragoza mentioned, so maybe from XEZR-850; out by 1132. (Hauser)
- 910 -PUERTO RICO? A semi-unid again, this sunday 12/8 at 0959 1/2-hit 00-1000 EE s/on w/call like WPRP, said 1000 watts full time and owned and operated by Grayson, Inc. - GM and President Lewis Hemingway. Then straight into full SS programs. Company,GM, power don't fit, but call and SS do. (Boyd)
- 1015 -EL SALVADOR "YSC, Radio Internacional, la manera mas economica para enterarse de todo", 12/9 1116. (Hauser)
- 1020 -COLOMBIA 9/12 1005 ad mentioning "toda la costa norte de Colombia", then back to program "Buenos Dias, campesinos de mi tierra"; must be Radio Panzenu, Monteria. (Hauser)
- 1025 -PANAMA 12/9 1012 NA, s/on w/ID as "Emisora de la Voz del Baru"; prayer to Mary. (Hauser)
- 1040 -CHINA Peking in good but fighting w/others, and gone by 1504. (Babarovich)
- 1045 -PANAMA? 12/5 0214 tropical mx, mention "Sistema..Santo Domingo.."; 0218 low het of about 200 hz; 0220 giving phone numbers; talk over mx. (Hauser)

- 1090 -MEXICO Probably XEHR the one giving the address of Apartado 1000 in Puebla, Puebla, 12/9 1112 u/KAAY OC, whose mx cuts, and GTA took o/by 1114. (Hauser)
- 1100 -COLOMBIA 12/9 1020 mx, "R. Reloj" ID, 5:23 TC; "la barrintera(?) de Barranquilla"; ad. TCs given twice, followed each time by trumpet-like trills; then into mx selection as "Recurdo No. 22". Best on LSB. (Hauser)
- 1120 -VENEZUELA "Ondas del Lago", ID 12/9 1029, #1,120, desde Maracaibo". (Hauser)
- 1130 -COLOMBIA Which is Todelar stn here? That's the only ID, by YL heard 12/9 1046. (Hauser) My guess would be HJAC, but not sure. (ED)
- 1140 -UNID 12/9 1047 SS nx, beeper every few seconds. WQBA? (Hauser)
- 1142 -CUBA Jammer noted absent 12/9 1033, but by 1204 seemed to be back. (Hauser)
- 1150 -MEXICO XERM Mexicali, B.C. has changed name to "Canal Tropical", ex-"Nueva R M" and is now all tropical, and no longer rock. Heard 12/9 0020-0030.
- VENEZUELA YVMV Ondas del Caribe, Punto Fijo 12/9 1037 dominating/ (Gleason) 8 hz SAH w/OC; Almacenes Caracas ad in bolivares, other ad for Punto Fijo, Almacenes Combate ad; Ondas del Caribe jingle, telefonos de emergencia, 6:41 TC, more ads, still 1043, including one on Avenida Colombia. Always enjoy SA's cutting through regional channels. (Hauser)
- 1170 -COLOMBIA La Voz de la Heroica, Cartagena ID u /KVOO OC; 12/9 1026. (Hauser)
- 1187 -GUATEMALA Likely R. Sonora the one 12/5 0210 w/SS ads, mx. (Hauser)
- 1200 -COLOMBIA (Harmonic) HJAV Monteria is being heard evenings on 2440. 12/5 0225 adstring, phone 36-90, ID like "R. Unica"; ad for Tolerante. polka mx; 0244 into yelly play-by-play, 0330 still, gone by 0400 check. 12/6 0115 tropical mx, adstrings, 0130 ID like "R. Pubica"; 0215 play-by-play past 0415. 12/7 already before 0100; 0128 ID mention 5 kw, several local ads for Monteria, 0228 more, phones always 4 digit; 0255 play-by-play, 0359 off. 12/9 1055 mx, better carrier than mod, as prelude, since 1102 ending NA, R. Cordobesa ID, RGN plug, half-asleep ancr; 1104:40 cut off. (Hauser)
- 1240 -MEXICO XEEN Ciudad Delicias, Chih. 12/5 1233-1247 w/ranchera and tropical mx, greetings to listeners and IDs as "B N, la onda feliz". First time hrd, was about 90% readable and stable. Only 4 more to complete Chih. (Gleason)
- MEXICO XEOV Orizaba, Veracruz 12/6 1138-1200 w/non-stop ranchera mx. At 1145 had ID as operating on 1240 w/250 watts. Call given w/the 0 and V pronounced together, which sort of rhyme w/"Veracruz". While I'm not 100% sure of this, its the only 1240 which pronounces this way, so a letter and tape off to them. This has to be far and away my best XE log. (Gleason)
- 1250 -MEXICO XESC Sabinas, Coah. 12/7 0030-0045. ID as "XESC, La Divertida" and had local ads, US and SS rock. S/off at 0045 w/at least 10 mentions of calls, so this CP is on. (Gleason)
- 1330 -MEXICO XETB Torreon, Coah. R. Laguna noted 1140-1200 w/romantic boleros w/ no ID until 1200 official s/on. Many Mexicans are on prior to listed s/on w/mx for as much as 30 minutes, usually without ID. (Gleason)
- 1370 -MEXICO XEHF Nogales, Son. 12/8 1220-1240 w/cl mx. At 1230 repeated call about 8 times, so must have been testing prior to RS. (Gleason)
- 1380 -MEXICO XEKT Tecate, B.C. noted AN 12/8. Heard 1100 w/"radiomaratón" to raise money. Many live musical acts, and talk w/big contributors. Never IDed, but frequent mentions of Tecate and local establishments. (Gleason)
- 1430 -UNID (Harmonic) SS, het, slightly off frequency on 2800 12/9 1053, mx; 1100 chimes; tough. (Hauser)
- 1595 -NICARAGUA YNKS, Chinandega "R. San Cristobal" 12/8 0420-0430 w/clear ID by name on a special broadcast of a live orchestra. (Gleason)
