CALIFORNIA CAN BE LOGGED IN FLORIDA

Hello. 'Tis over a year since my last Muse, so a re-intro: 24, B.S. in Chemical engineering, & a home computer enthusiast (TRS-80). Having become a victim of this latest recession (laid off 1st "pril") I have plenty of spare time on my hands, though work on my Master's degree has kept me somewhat busy. DX though has taken a back seat to other interests lately, although I have in the last few days been bandscanning a bit more. WBBK-780 was heard at 5am yesterday (11/13), & KNX was in rather weak & lam 11/10 w/storm news. Oth-erness: In October ED MITKUS & I toured a number of Pinellas County stations, including WNSI-1380, formerly NX-TLK, now semi-simulcasting w/sister station WRBQ-104.7, the (almost) inimitable "Q-105" (so don't be fooled when you hear the Q-105 ID on 1380!). During the night hours WNSI always plays songs roughly 10 minutes after the FM rocker airs them, a practice termed "shadow-castings" by the PD. Watch for the AM to adopt the WRBQ calls by the first of the year. U. of S. Florida BKB is on WPLP-570, after a protracted search by USP officials to find a station after WFLA dropped them last season. Last year at this time, 4 Bay Area stations (WFLP, WFLA, WDAE & WNSI) had night SX TLK programs; now that WNSI has dropped theirs, there are no such programs here now! With their "nostalgic oldies" format, they ought to swap equipment with WRBQ ("AM-105-AM") - note how they distinguish themselves from Q-105! I wish I could afford 7 1/2 acres as stated in my last Muse, but I have made a typo. It is only 7 1/2 acres more or less, barely enough to hold a 600' mini-bavarae (which until now I have not had time to erect). The poor TA CX are consistent with the general trend that geomagnetic activity, and hence absorption, tend to peak about a year or two after sunspot maxima. Speaking of DX CX, I recently read that the Earth's magnetic field is declining and will vanish in about 1,000 years hence at the present rate of decline. It is therefore interesting to speculate on BCB CX in the distant future as the Earth's magnetic field approaches zero. According to magnetoclonic theory it would seem that the most conspicuous effect will be that gyrofrequency will decline to zero, & as it does the absorption of the extraordinary mode will decrease, thereby enhancing BCB DX. Unfortunately none of us will live long enough (I presume) to witness this improvement. Pity! The conclusion of enhancement depends upon the assumption that collision frequency (which also determines absorption) will remain unchanged. Whether or not this assumption is reasonable - cannot say because the theory of collision frequency is not adequately developed at present. So much for speculation. Because of the current poor CX most of my recent activities have centered around overhauling my "new" R-390A/URR. Best DX to all for the coming holiday seasons.

Howdy y'all from the Ear of the Everglades. Time for me to report in and to keep all posted on what is happening in LA DX paradise. First off new DX heard: HJCX-700 R. Substanz - h'zz - that's all I am suffering w/a bad powerline noise at my new location. I have bugged the power company about it - if it isn't fixed like it should be, I am going to call the FCC! I just revised my index card log. Domestic DX - 468 heard, 359 taped and/or verified, or 76.7% of those only heard & logged. I also have over 250 foreign DX stations logged, but have not as yet decided how I am going to count all the Cuban XR changes, and call changes. I count call changes on all domestic stations, and accept taped receptions in lieu of a verie. This Halloween weekend I went thru my meager junk box and have scrapped enough parts to build my version of RON SCHATZ' famous LSCA cardioid antenna system. It has finally got to the point where I have got to use something other than just a loop to rid the BCE of all the Cuban and LA stations which jam the BCE dial here every night. The unit I have planned to build uses my Radio West MW-1 ferrite loop and a very touchy antenna tuner. When I mean touchy - I mean just a slight bit of mistuning of the tuner will destroy the cardioid pattern - even hand capacitance can affect it. I will use a 40 meter dipole antenna as the other 'leg' of the LSCA. I have a prototype put together on my DX desk, and will give it a try tonight. Here is a tip to those who are strictly loop users when DXing MW- connect a good earth ground to your receiver - it will mean an extra S-unit or two in signal strength going into your RX. MW stations must have a good ground system to radiate a good signal, & a DXer needs a good ground to receive them! It is also good for safety reasons. (C.N.I.)

Tentative on KRDO, not counting it, tape not running of course. KRCO @ 4:30pm. 11/5- KVLV s/off after furniture store ad "R. 98" promos @ 4:34pm. KINS @ 4:38 w/roundtable pizza spot, into Willie Nelson (again!) KNEY "Cannery Radio" in @ 5:51 u/a mess. KELK (this one's been on my "on host wanted list for almost five years!) @ 6pm into net NX. Tentative on KSUE this eve also w/a tire store ad, but no firm ID. 11/6- KPOD @ 5:55pm, KRO1, KFLI & KSRV were also heard. 11/7- KNCO @ 5:45 also KPRB - only second time heard here. KGMS IDed @ 6:16 w/snow phone ad. 11/8- KSRV again, in like a local w/"Farmer's Supply Co-Op" commercial @ 5:20pm. Also someone weak u/KEED @ 6:35 w/Charlie Pride, femme DJ. KELK in again @ 6:34pm w/Elko WX (219!) 11/9- Tentative on KPRO w/Lakers BKB @ 7:45pm. CFCP IDed @ 8:25pm, mentioning their relay. 11/12 - KGER u/KSLM's Blazer game w/REL @ 6:45pm. KXGA IDed @ 6:55pm, into R NX, then ski report & CA headlines. 11/13 KDOT again @ 4:22pm w/wx, then into Herb Alpert (Willie who?) That's what's gone into the log book so far this month. "SOME ENCHANTED EVENING" FROM "SOUTH PACIFIC"

Hello again. After last week's report of DX here's a look at the BCB across parts of the South Pacific. WUVU-648 American Samoa is 10kw from a 250' tower, now 24 hours, NSF. Very bilingual UPI tty (??-ERC77) NX on the hour but about 50/50 EE & Samoa commercials & mx. Most music is intro'd in the language of the song. They're good IDers though, always in EE. Excellent daytime signal 300 miles out to sea. Their night signal has reached as far as Germany according to the receptionist. Also a new station, KBQN-585 w/50kw is due to start 12/1 according to "another DX club". Unfortunately I found out about KBQN the day after the ship returned back here to Honolulu, upon receipt of two weeks' accumulation of mail. However I did not notice any new towers or signs of another station. I rented a Jonda w/a fair AK radio. From E end of Tutuila Island an AK Samoa BX, A32-1017 longs with native mx. Many Honolulu AMs heard right after dark - regular strong signals from KKUA-690 & KUMU-1500, all at 2300 miles. Very little DX done on ship on way down/back due to Radar interferences, pretty much wipes out BCB, not helping much is our 1kw RATT! Most DX done "sitting on the dock on the bay" at Pago Pago - next Muse - W. Samoa Radio. Finally I have had a good time DXing w/fellow NRCers BOB HLIVAK & AL MARIANI - I'm still looking for good combo RX & recorder similar to Superadio 5280. All my present DX is Panasonic RP888 into "walkman" style recorder - very cumbersome! Bye.
