**WKBI-1400 St. Marys PA** will test on Sunday, March 31, from 0000-0001, 0100-0101, 0200-0201, and 0300-0301 ELT with 1000 Watts nondirectional. Test will be 60 seconds of Morse code and sweep tones at the top of each hour. QSLs by postal mail ONLY, please include a SASE. No e-mail requests or phone calls for any reason. **50 YEARS AGO** – From the February 16, 1963 issue of *DX News* – Ron Schiller returned to DXing and to Musings after a three-year layoff; seven DX tests were scheduled for Monday morning, March 4 – from CJLX-800 Fort William ON, CJCJ-920 Woodstock NB, CKBC-1360 Bathurst NB, WMHI-1370 Braddock Heights MD, WKFD-1370 Wickford RI, WEAL-1510 Greensboro NC, and WYOU-1550 Tampa FL.

**25 YEARS AGO** – From the February 29, 1988 issue of *DX News* – Several pages were devoted to the details of the ANARC convention to be held July 13-16 in Irvine, California.

- 830 WUMY TN **Memphis** – Applies for license to cover CP for U1 8000/2.

- 1340 KFMD AR **Bethel Heights** – CP for new station applies for license to cover, U1 1000/1000; this means they are ready to start testing.

Now the station (which has been silent since receiving the FCC letter) is pleading for a waiver and license reinstatement, pleading that the person who knew the FCC rules had left the station and they failed to file the renewal out of confusion.

## NOAA Space Weather Outlook

Issued February 11 – For the period February 11-March 9, 2013

Solar activity is expected to be very low to low.

No proton events are expected at geosynchronous orbit.

The greater than 2 MeV electron flux at geosynchronous orbit is expected to be at normal to moderate levels for most of the week, possibly reaching high levels on 13 - 18 February in response to positive polarity coronal holes/high speed streams (CHs/HSSs) 93 and 94.

Geomagnetic field activity is expected to be predominately quiet, with isolated unsettled conditions on 12 Feb, when the Hyder flare CME mentioned earlier is expected to arrive. Quiet to unsettled conditions are expected to persist through 16 February due to CH HSS effects.

Separate schedules are available for WTAN itself, with some duplication, such as 1787. **(GH-OK)**

- 940 **CUBA** *R.Progreso*, Sancti Spíritus FEB 11 1000 – Fair while tuned to high side to avoid XEQ het; chime with time check into “A Primera Hora” program. New log. [Conti-NH]
- 939.88 **MEXICO** XEQ *Bésame*, México, DF FEB 9 0900 – Fair; “Nueve cuarenta es la noche...” and tractor trailer horn with mention of camino and México sounding like an overnight trucking program, but online program schedule only lists música de la radio apasionada. [Conti-NH]
- 960 **MEXICO** unID FEB 12 0600-0605 – A little bit of everything but no IDs during local KGWA unmodulated Fox-hole: 0601 romantic music in Spanish, so XEK or XEFAMA; 0602 mixing with blues, so WABG Mississippi; 0603 ABC news so KMA Iowa. [Hauser-OK]
- 990 **CUBA** *R.Guamá*, Pinar del Río FEB 11 0500 – Under WDCX open carrier; choral national anthem and ID with chimes parallel 1070 kHz. [Conti-NH]
- 990 **MEXICO** XEER Cd. Cuauhtémoc, Chih. FEB 14 0417 – PSA from “El gobierno de la republica,” two “Estereo Romance 92.9” slogans, a couple of new items then into música romántica. Good signal. [Knight-AZ]
- 1030 **MEXICO** XELJ Lagos de Moreno, Jal. FEB 7 0101 – In and out ID at 0101 “105.7 FM y 1030 AM... veinte mil wats... XHLJ... XELJ... la ke buena...” The “La Ke Buena” slogan was heard frequently. Poor in partial phase of local XEYC and mix of KBUF Kansas and KTWO Wyoming. [Vance-TX]

- 1070 **CUBA** *R.Guamá*, Guane FEB 11 0500 – Over/under CHOK; ascending chimes marking the hour, choral national anthem, and canned ID by a woman accompanied by a distinctive chime-like melody, parallel 990 kHz. [Conti-NH]
- 1090 **MEXICO** XEAU Monterrey, NL JAN 26 0320 – Fair with lengthy dialogue between man and woman, then a 103.7 FM ID. Confirmed by comparing this to the webstream of XHFMTU 103.7, which XEAU simulcasts. Most likely the same station heard the night before after 0600 UTC with American pop oldies from the 1970s including “One of These Nights” by The Eagles and Paul Simon’s “Kodachrome.” [Dau-NE]
- 1090 **MEXICO** XEMCA Tampico, Tamps. JAN 26 0346 – Fair with “XEMCA... Corazón Romántico” ID heard after romantic pop ballads. [Dau-NE]
- 1100 **MEXICO** XENAS Navajoa, Son. FEB 14 0315 – Fair signal mostly under local KFNX with dance and hip-hop music, mentioned “95.5” (FM) and “en Navajoa” clearly, MST time checks, “Unica 95 punto 5.” [Knight-AZ]
- 1140 **CUBA** *R.Surco*, Morón FEB 11 0500 – Under WRVA; choral national anthem, canned CMIP *R.Surco* ID accompanied by organ/synth music. [Conti-NH]
- 1140 **MEXICO** XEMR *R.Esperanza*, Monterrey NL FEB 9 0900 – Under WRVA; woman with Esperanza and México mentions. Relatively good Mexico reception conditions this morning. [Conti-NH]
- 1180 **CUBA** *R.Rebelde*, multiple sites FEB 9 0421 – Fair/clear signal, KERN nulled. Man talking then “Rebelde” mentioned by woman, into soft vocal parallel 5025 kHz shortwave. [Knight-AZ]
- 1350 **MEXICO** XECTZ Cuetzalán de Progreso, Pue. JAN 13 1202 – Fade up at presumed sign-on with Mexican national anthem, ID by woman, “XECTZ, La Voz de la Sierra Norte...” into a news or talk program hosted by same or another woman. Pretty tough as it was in and out of the mix. [Vance-TX]
- 2910 **MEXICO** XEVT Villahermosa, Tab. FEB 11 1155-1219 – Very poor signal but usual Spanish morning news magazine with some music, from 3 x 970 XEVT, our most persistent and regular MW harmonic, along with 2660 KGLD Texas. Ever-increasing storm noise level disrupts our 2 MHz DXing. Following story is of interest because it refers to XEVT at the end, about the migration of AM stations to FM, in this case in Tabasco state.
