Tower Fire

MARQUETTE, Mich. (WLUC TV6) - A fire on Monday (Dec. 30) destroyed the WDMJ AM 1320 radio tower in Marquette. According to Sovereign Communications, the owner of WDMJ, the fire was in the tuning shed at the base of the 260-foot tower. The shed was fully engulfed in flames and the heat from the fire compromised the base of the tower, causing it to collapse. WDMJ and the Catholic radio station WNOA-FM 103.9, that also uses the tower, are currently off the air.

Sovereign Communications hopes to have a temporary antenna installed to get both stations back on the air over the next few days. The estimated cost of repairs is a minimum of \$250,000

From *Radio Insight*:

Legendary talker Don Imus passed away this morning (Dec. 27) at the age of 79

The longtime Cleveland and New York disk jockey turned syndicated political talker passed away at Baylor Scott and White Medical Center in College Station TX, after being hospitalized since Christmas Eve according to a statement released by his family. No cause of death was released.

Imus' career can be broken into three distinct parts. He began his broadcasting career in 1968 at KUTY Palmdale CA. After bouncing around California and WGAR Cleveland for a few years, he joined 660 WNBC New York in December 1971 for his first run that lasted until 1977. He then returned to Cleveland at 1420 WHK for afternoons until returning to WNBC in 1979 through its sale and flip to Sports WFAN in October 1988. During that time he was one of the VJ's at VH-1 when it launched in 1984.

At WFAN his show moved completely into the political spectrum as he then entered syndication in 1993. Many other well-known broadcasters would launch their careers as part of the Imus show including Mike Francesa, Christopher 'Mad Dog' Russo, Mike Breen, and current WABC New York morning hosts Sid Rosenburg and Bernard McGuirk. In 1996 Imus In The Morning added a national television simulcast on the newly launched MSNBC that would last until his April 2007 racist comments about the Rutgers University women's basketball team that led to his termination from WFAN and MSNBC.

Imus would then join 770 WABC in December 2007 and re-entered syndication while his show was aired on Fox Business Network until 2015. In his final years he has hosted his show from his ranch in Texas while the remainder of the staff remained in New York until his retirement in March 2018.

During his career Imus won four Marconi Awards, three for Major Market Personality of the Year (1990, 1992 and 1997) and one for Network Syndicated Personality (1994). He was inducted into the National Radio Hall of Fame in 1989.

Imus dedicated his large cattle ranch in New Mexico to support kids with cancer and many other fund-raisers for that cause throughout his career.

Imus is survived by his wife Deirdre Coleman and six children sons Wyatt and Lt. Zachary Don Cates and daughters Nadine, Ashley, Elizabeth and Toni.

Last time I ended with locals KBJD-1650 and KRKS-990 with OC and no programming about 0000 ELT. It got better! About 0100 on 10/24 KKSE-950 was totally off! Added KJR at 0400, KDCE at 0800, XEKAM at 0859 and KAH1 at 0900, all were new and taped. On the foreign from I was able to tape JOUB-774 and JOIB-747 at 0600 new tapes for the collection and JOAB-693 at 0500 which was new. A new country added was South Korea with HLAZ-1566 taped at 0500 and HLCA-972 taped at 0600. Rounding out some more logbook additions from 10/24 were KSVE-1650 "Juan AM" at 0001, KKAG-1460 at 0100, KMER-940 with C&W and "The Spur" slogan, and WNDZ-750 with their s/on at 0800. Next set of tapes where 10/29 – 10/31. Decided with a real cold snap predicted it might help with noise. Call changes added 10/29 KRXO-1270 (ex-KTUZ), 10/30 KTNO-620 (ex-KEXB), WTAQ-1360 at 0800 last logged in 1991 as WGEE, WRTO-1200 at 0800 last logged as WOPA in 1990 and KKZZ-1520 on 10/31 at 0100 last logged as KACY from my Colorado Springs QTH in 1978! New ones so far from these tapes include XESDD-1030 with a ToH call ID on 10/30 at 2100, XEGS-610 new log at 2200 with "La Primera Estacion" slogan per IRCA 2019 Mexican list then a surprise in KNCO-830 at 2300 with no sign of usual WCCO. 10/31 at 0100 had a new one with KCBC-770 topping KKOBB with a ToH ID.

One thing I've done over the years is keep a running DX Season total logs starting September 1 through the following September 1. Last season my total was 426 with spotty activity though the year, so far this year I'm at 491 total logs including 37 new stations and 8 call changes. My top year since I started keeping the year by year totals in 2003 was 2004 with 576 stations logged. This year I'll see if my 2019-2020 totals will surpass that. That's it for 'til next issue 73

- WBMS MA **Brockton** – 12/16 1525 – Rock music, ID for WATD 95.9 and “WATD, the holiday spirit of the South Shore”, Kathy Dean is the DJ. Good signal with fades, WATD also simulcasts on WMEX-1510, no usual WOPG. (TF-NH)
- WVOX NY **New Rochelle** – 12/15 1615 – Perry Como music, weak signal with deep fades, soon gone. I have heard WVOX once here before; they sound like listening to radio in the 1950's. I am told by a friend in the industry that the station tries to appeal to the thousands of mostly mature residents of nearby Co-op City in The Bronx. (TF-NH)

Maybe an Anthropology lecture, but way beyond anything that one would expect to hear on the radio. WWNN formats, according to the NRC Log, “Health and Wealth Talk Radio”. Poor with fading. **(GL-NH)**
- 1480 WRCK NY **Remsen** – 12/1 1200 – “AM 1480, 94.1 FM WRCK Remsen, New York...your positive music choice” ToH ID. Back on air after being silent for some time, sounding far less than their former 5000 watts. **(HPR-NY)**
- WDJO OH **Cincinnati** – 12/1 2149 – “I Want You Back” by the Jackson Five, “Cincinnati’s Oldies Network, WDJO” ID, local ads into Iron Butterfly song. **(HPR-NY)**
- 1500 WFIF CT **Milford** – 12/25 0730 – “You’re listening to Life Changing Radio, we’re WFIF...New Haven area” by man. Lots of static and fading. **(GL-NH)**
- 1510 WRRD WI **Waukesha** – 12/29 1700 – Under WPGR; “WRRD 1510 AM Waukesha-Milwaukee, streaming at News Talk 1510 AM dot com,” and Westwood One news. **(BC-NH)**

- 1650 CKZW QC **Montreal** – 12/19 1619 – Alternating with CINA with Christian talk by woman, focusing on dysfunctional families and the holidays. “This is Montreal’s Christian radio” at 1629, then faded into CINA. Poor. **(GL-NH)**
- 1670 WOZN WI **Madison** – 12/28 0703 – No sign of CJEU, EE sports talk about quarterbacks. Confirmed via web stream. Very poor with lots of QRM and fading. **(GL-NH)**

- 1520 WHOW IL Clinton – 12/24 0905 – Poor, with CBS News, Illinois state temperatures, finally "33 degrees and fog". "Regional Radio WHOW". Alone. (JJR-WI)
- 1540 WSMI IL Litchfield – 12/20 0826 – Poor -- I don't sit on 1540 much, so Christmas music over KXEL stood out! Calls heard, in nice fade up. Last logged in 1980, making it RARE! (JJR-WI)
- 1550 WKTF GA Vienna – 12/24 0834 – Oldies (Rod Stewart, The Beatles, The Byrds, David Lee Roth, Steam, Buffett), some co-channel WAMA Mexi-Spanish and what turns out to be WLOR Christmas stunting with mostly secular Christmas songs. WKTF, with an ad for a restaurant with ". . . a waterfront view from over the lake . . . fresh shrimp . . ." and 229 Area Code (that's Vienna), and ". . . Auto Parts is a proud sponsor of the Bibb County . . .". Bibb would be Macon, north of Vienna. Then at 1611 [?? – Ed.] recheck: "Adams Pharmacy with a drive-through and free delivery on 16th Avenue, Cordele" (just south of Vienna) which is indeed the pharmacy and location when Googled. This ad pops up often. WKTF is widely reported to have returned to the air in June with a new buyer who's brokering. Definitely Oldies format and not gospel, at least during my listens. No active web stream, of course. Thought I heard a canned reference to "1550 AM and 99.3" but not certain. FCC dB does show a 99.3 translator in nearby Cordele, and one in more unlikely and distant Albany. (TK-FL)
- 1560 KLNG IA Council Bluffs – 12/21 0800 – LID, talk of podcasts and apps. Poor, with WGLB open carrier. (JJR-WI)
- 1590 KVGB KS Great Bend – 12/20 0853 – "News From the Oil Patch", with updates from the oil and gas industry; several ads followed and LID at 0900. Fair. (JW-CO)
- 1600 KATZ MO Saint Louis – 12/24 0900 – Poor, with ". . . more great GOS music", LID, "I-Heart . . .". Alone. (JJR-WI)

- 800 KPDQ OR Portland – 10/26 0959 – Ad for ‘Billy Graham Evangelistic Association’ event, followed by ID. 627 miles. Relog.
- 800 KDDD TX Dumas – 10/25 2148 – Faded up over XEROK and PJB with high school football: Sunray Bobcats at Panhandle Panthers, sponsored by ‘Dalhart Federal Credit Union’ in Dumas. (Panhandle was already up 69-6 in the 3rd quarter, and would go on to win 69-12). “You’re listening to Bobcats football on K-triple-D”. Listed 8 Watts nights. Still using slogan “The farm station, all ag, all day”. Listed 30 Watts PSRA. Even if they were already on 250 Watt day rig, it is surprising how big a dent they can put in XEROK. 699 miles. Relog.
- 800 CHAB SK Moose Jaw – 10/25 2257 – Over KBRV, with “Grace to You” religious program, “Thank you for joining us for this hour of inspirational programming on 800 CHAB . . . ‘Back to the Bible’ is next”. Ads for ‘Culligan Water Service’ 270 Caribou St West in Moose Jaw, and ‘Nelson GM’ in Assiniboia. Promo for ‘Dick Bartley’s Classic Hits’ Saturdays at Eight and Sundays at noon, sponsored by ‘Primary Eye Care Center’, ‘Moose Jaw Fuel _____’, and a few others. “The greatest hits of all time, CHAB . . . a Golden West Radio Station” and back to inspirational programming. 888 miles. Relog.
- 810 KLVZ CO Brighton – 10/26 0814 – Mixing with KBHB. Adult standards, “Legends 8-10 Denver” slogan, and announcement about how their signal isn’t very good at night, and advising listeners to tune into their web stream instead. This station and sister station KLDC-1220 have become pests in recent years. 495 miles. Relog.
- 810 WHB MO Kansas City – 10/28 0830 – Appeared suddenly over KLVZ (“Legends 8-10”) upon switch to day rig, with morning show “The Border Patrol” on “Sports radio 8-10 WHB”. 1040 miles. Relog.
- 810 KSWV NM Santa Fe – 10/25 2003 – Mixing with KGO, KBHB, and KLVZ. “The drive home with Anthony Gonzales” afternoon drive show. “AM 8-10 and 99.9 FM translator K260CT Santa Fe” into “Today’s official drive home shout-out”. 500 miles. Relog.
- 810 WGY NY Schenectady – 10/24 2107 – ID and weather forecast. 2084 miles. Relog.
- 810 KBHB SD Sturgis – 10/25 1959 – ID: “The voice of the best people on earth, the American rancher, we are the big 81, KBHB Sturgis” into ABC News. 660 miles. Relog.
- 810 KXOI TX Crane – 10/25 2133 – Spanish Contemporary Christian music (resembling other musical formats like ranchera, but having contemporary Christian themes), female announcer gave slogan: “Radio Alabanza 810 AM” and invited listeners to call in. 500 Watts nights. 841 miles. Relog.

- 1370 KXTL MT Butte – 10/25 2259 – Under KSOP as usual, with talk programming, network ads, and ID, which was miscued (they played two ID liners on top of each other.) 485 miles. Relog.
- 1370 KAWL NE York – 10/26 0759 – Oldies and ID a few minutes after the top of the hour. Listed 500 Watts PSRA. 878 miles. Relog.
- 1370 KWNC WA Quincy – 10/16 0204 – Way under KXTL, with news, “Talk 106.7” slogan and weather. Listed 39 Watts nights. 638 miles. Relog.
- 1380 KLPZ AZ Parker – 10/25 2257 – On top of KOTA, with high school football: Parker Broncs at Tonopah Valley Phoenix, sponsored by ‘Parker Oil Products’. 339 miles. Relog.
- 1380 KTKZ CA Sacramento – 10/25 2158 – Promo for “Money Matters” program on “Talk 13-80”. 407 miles. Relog.

- 1380 KKRX OK Lawton – 10/25 2210 – Rose up above the mess with Oklahoma City Thunder basketball. 918 miles. Relog.
- 1380 KOTA SD Rapid City – 10/25 1957 – Pregame for Rapid City Rush hockey. 657 miles. Relog.
- 1380 KHEY TX El Paso – 10/25 2159 – Faded up for ID: “We are Sports Radio 13-80 KHEY El Paso” and back to Fox Sports. A few days later, I heard a promo where they called themselves “auténtico [sic] sports radio”. 663 miles. Relog.

- 1390 KLTX CA Long Beach – 10/25 2257 – Spanish religious program; new slogan: “Radio Inspiración” and ID. 424 miles. Relog.
- 1390 KGNU CO Denver – 10/25 1957 – End of BBC news program, followed by guitar music and ID. 484 miles. Relog.
- 1390 KENN NM Farmington – 10/25 2057 – High school football pregame for Gallup Miyamura Patriots at Farmington Scorpions. 360 miles. Relog.

- 1390 KZGD OR Salem – 10/25 2137 – Regional Mexican music, “La grande” slogan. 617 miles. Relog.
- 1390 KLGN UT Logan – 10/25 1957 – College sports play-by-play, sponsored by local ‘Jared’s Jewelers’, new slogan: “106.9 the fan,” reflecting change of translator frequency. 218 miles. Relog.
- 1390 KBBO WA Yakima – 10/25 2159 – ‘Washington State National Guard’ PSA, slogan “13-90 AM and 104.5 FM The Fan” and legal ID. 611 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KSUN AZ Phoenix – 10/28 0758 – Ads for local Phoenix area businesses in Spanish. ID and “la mejor” slogan. 407 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KTUC AZ Tucson – 10/25 2200 – Adult Standards, ID: “14 hundred KTUC Tucson, a Cumulus station, powered by GMC”. This station is a pest on any southern wire. 498 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KCYK AZ Yuma – 10/28 0759 – ID: “Outlaw Country, KCYK Yuma”. 443 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KIHG CA Eureka – 10/25 2359 – Top-of-hour ID and Relevant Radio mention. 547 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KRLN CO Canon City – 10/27 2053 – Jingle ID. 476 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KJYE CO Delta – 10/27 2100 – ID buried under KBLJ. 320 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KFTM CO Fort Morgan – 10/25 0127 – ID mentioned “. . . on the AM dial since 1949, now on 94.1 FM”. 548 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KBLJ CO La Junta – 10/25 2209 – On top of channel with high school football: Colorado Springs Classical Academy Titans at La Junta Tigers.

- 1400 KSPT ID Sandpoint – 10/25 2318 – Mixing with KEDO (and possibly a third station), with high school football: (halftime update) Sandpoint Bulldogs at Seattle Evergreen Wolverines, mentioning the ‘Sayers Jewelers Player of the Game’. 650 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KXGF MT Great Falls – 10/25 2215 – High school football: Great Falls Russell Rustlers at Great Falls Bison, sponsored by ‘Max Casino/Sports Bar’ and ‘Great Falls College’. 596 miles. Relog.
- 1400 KCOW NE Alliance – 10/25 2124 – High school football: Lexington Minutemen at Alliance Bulldogs including ID. 621 miles. Relog.

- 162 **FRANCE** *TDF Allouis* DEC 31 2220 – Solid s5 signal, poorly modulated with contemporary music. [Conti-NH]
- 183 **GERMANY** *Europe 1*, Felsberg DEC 31 2215 – Poor with deep fade outs; talk in French. Carrier off at 2229 UTC. Checked online European KiwiSDR receivers, and sure enough 183 is history. [Conti-NH]
- 198 **UNITED KINGDOM** *BBC Radio 4*, Droitwich et al. DEC 31 2225 – Poor; music documentary program. [Conti-NH]
- 549 **ALGERIA** *Jil FM*, Sidi Hamadouche DEC 28 0558 – Good; choral marching band national anthem parallel weaker 531 kHz. DEC 29 0458 – Good; choral marching band national anthem. [Conti-NH]
- 891 **ALGERIA** *R.Algérienne*, Ouled Fayet DEC 22 0144 – 1 kHz het upon WLS, from presumed RTA near Algiers; so then a quick look for other TA carriers: 531, 576 also Algeria; 936 Morocco, 1215 UK. DEC 23 0700 – Weak talk presumed RTA Arabic separable from WLS. [Hauser-OK] DEC 24 0213 – Chanting male vocal with signal peaking to fair level. [Beu-TX] DEC 26 0353 – Arabic talk barely audible against 890 WLS, but this is the strongest of the usual TA carriers. [Hauser-OK] DEC 31 0300 – Poor in local 900 WGHM interference. (WGHM is 3 miles east of me.) After a brief test period broadcasting a continuous 1 kHz tone, 891 returned to the airwaves in December. Mark Connelly in Massachusetts via CapeDX reported reception parallel 576 and 1422 kHz. [Conti-NH]
- 909 **UNITED KINGDOM** *BBC Radio 5* synchros DEC 26 0353 – Some audio on 909 against 910 stations. [Hauser-OK] DEC 28 1000 – Het against 910 WBZU while local 900 WGHM was open carrier; presumed *BBC5* rather than transpacific. Signals also noted on 693, 882, 1089, and 1215 kHz indicative of UK. [Conti-NH]
- 1089 **UNITED KINGDOM** *TalkSport* synchros DEC 27 0705 – Woman conducting sports interviews. Signal frequently peaking to fair level. [Beu-TX]
- 1521 **SAUDI ARABIA** *SBC R.Riyadh*, Duba DEC 27 2226 – Tell-tale 1-kHz het upon 1520 KOKC, from the 2 megawatts in Duba. I keep listening carefully for its expected cutoff around 2230-2231. Not heard after 2230:54, although at first seemed off some 20 seconds earlier, but hard to tell with music interference from KOKC commercial, and/or some fading. Het was the same pitch as from 891 upon 890 KTLR and WLS. So this time it is certainly not the nearby 1520.7 station. [Hauser-OK]
- Transatlantic carrier search:* DEC 15 0256-0300 – 531, 558, 576, 675, 684, 693, 711(stronger), 738, 747, 774(2), 837(2), 882, 909, 999(2), 1008, 1017, 1026, 1053, 1062, 1089, 1179, 1215, 1431 kHz. [Hauser-OK]

- 690 **CUBA** *R.Progreso*, Santa Clara//Santiago de Cuba DEC 31 0900 – Good; "Su Reportero RP," bell with time check, "Cuatro en punto." [Conti-NH]
- 810 **COLOMBIA** *HJCY Caracol Radio*, Bogotá DEC 23 1105 – News talk with man and woman announcers. Fair signal. [Beu-TX]
- 860 **MEXICO** *XEMO La Poderosa*, Tijuana, BC DEC 24 1401 – National anthem in progress, followed by garbled ID and "La Poderosa" slogan; prayer followed. Fair peaks, competing with KKOW, KNAI, and CBKF-2. [Wilkins-CO]
- 940 **MEXICO** *XEQ Ke Buena*, México, DF DEC 21 1101 – Fair; *Ke Buena* ID's and jingles. [Conti-NH]
- 1150 unID DEC 19 0023 – Mexican music roughly west/southwest-east/northeast with KSAL nulled; maybe per NRC AM Log, KNMM Albuquerque listed at 1500/105 watts in Spanish but format undefined beyond that. Or KHRO El Paso, 5000/380 *R.Ministar* in Spanish but supposed to be religious. At first I did not consider XE's this early but IRCA Mexican log shows two possibilities around same direction: XERM Mexicali and XEUAS Culiacan. [Hauser-OK]
- 1460 **MEXICO** *XEYC R.Fórmula*, Cd. Juárez, Chih. DEC 16 1331 – National anthem in progress at this unusual time; talk followed with mentions of Chihuahua and *R.Fórmula*. No other ID heard. Rough copy in the mix, with just 1000 watts. [Wilkins-CO]

- 1510 **ECUADOR** HCIO2 *R.Naval*, Guayaquil DEC 25 0721 – Time signal (beeps) detected under co-channel WLAC and XEQI. First station from Ecuador! [Beu-TX]
- 1620 **U.S. VIRGIN ISLANDS** WDHP *The Reef*, Frederiksted DEC 31 0259 – Under/over *R.Rebelde*; "Number one... 103.5 The Reef," and urban Caribbean music. [Conti-NH]

TRANS-PACIFIC DX

- 846 **KIRIBATI** *R.Kiribati*, London, Christmas Island DEC 25 0450 – Carrier here stronger than several of the regular TA ones from Algeria, Spain, UK, and since there are only low-powers in Europe on 846, as usual I assume this one really be TP from London where the sun is already setting on one of the Xmas islands, on Xmas day! [Hauser-OK]
- 945 unID DEC 31 1100 – Noted steady carrier while listening to 940 XEQ. Measured 945.000 kHz. Checked for additional signals and observed unID carriers at 693, 774, 972, 1512, and 1557 kHz, indicating an opening toward Japan, Korea, and Taiwan. Tim Tromp in Michigan via the NRC Facebook group reported similar, but only 774 Japan produced readable audio. [Conti-NH]

BENIN: 1476 Sérakou started testing with 35 kW in November. The same Sérakou site as 1566 kHz, but 1476 kHz beamed to Nigeria. Also relays ELWA. Next they will test with 100 kW and start regularly in February with 200 kW. [Mauno Ritola, ARC mv-eko]

ECUADOR: The official Excel station lists of the Ecuadorian Ministerio de Telecomunicaciones have about three dozen such lists going back to 2016. To see them all go to Google and search for the listado RTV site www.arcotel.gob.ec. Then under tools select "past year" from the time option to see the most recent ones. Note that the most recent lists do not have the year in the file name although the date does appear in the body of the spreadsheet. The most recent (October 2019) is at www.arcotel.gob.ec/wp-content/uploads/2018/11/8.1.3-Listado_RTV-Oct-2019.xlsx, and the oldest (August 2016) at www.arcotel.gob.ec/wp-content/uploads/2016/10/9.1.3-Listado_RTV-modificado-Ago2016.xlsx. If the file opens in the "indice" tab, switch to the "listado" tab. The lists include all licensed AM, FM, and TV stations in Ecuador. [Don Moore, visiting Cuenca, Ecuador]

GERMANY: *Europe 1* announced with short notice that **183 kHz** would cease operation on December 31, 2019. "End of an era started in 1955. In a context of digitization, and also of savings, the flagship of Lagardère will turn off its Grandes Ondes transmitter," explained Anne Fauconnier, General Secretary of the Lagardère radio group, Europe 1, RFM and Virgin Radio. Environmental concerns were also cited. [La Lettre de la Radio.pro]

Unreported Domestic Stations

One new station on the air was reported to DDXD for the first time (CIRF-1350), and the portion of Tim Hall's DXpedition report printed in this issue contains six stations that had not been reported to DDXD since at least Volume 67 (1999-2000): KBLG-910, KYAK-930, KDYM-1230, KRJW-1240, KACI-1300, and KBBO-1390.

This takes us down to 324 full-service (100 watts and up) AM stations in the United States and Canada that have not been reported to DDXD during this time. The last full list was printed in Volume 86 Issue 19. Can you report one next time?
