RANDOLPH HUNT-LEUCADIA,CALIF-Veries since last Bulletin and number of days each report was out. KTUC ex KGAR 7, WPAD 9, KWLK 13, KINY 27 and KINY 55, KGDM 102, JOCK1 44, JOAK1 45 and JOAK2 75 both cards received in same envelope. JOBK1 69 and JOIK 60. Here is a quote from Chief Engineer of KINY, "I sent out a verification after receiving your first letter, however, one of the boys at Federal Building was appropriating handfuls of mail searching for whatever he could find. Consequently, many people here in Juneau have been finding out that their mail never reached its destination. Thats all over now with said would be mail clerk safely ensconced in an air conditioned room in the local Bastille, so I have hopes of this letter reaching you" This letter verified March and April frequency checks. My JO veries now total 98 from 35 different stations. In a few days I am going to try out a Skyrider 23 and a Meissner Master (wired at the factory) trying to get a good set so I can make it interesting for the lads on the next S & E I hope, Hi.

BOB BOTZUM-READING PENNA. Looks like ole man static is here to stay. The past season was the best I had for few yrs. I increased my log of verification from 960 to 1045. Added the following new T.A. veries-Milan, Sottens, Nice Coted Azur, Toulouse, Marseilles, (S.A.) PRG2, LRA, LS11. (T*P) 3WV, 3DB, 2GZ, 3SR, 4AY. Have reports still out to, Grenoble, HJLABN, TIXD, LT-1, 4AK, 2UW, 7HT, 2CH, 2KO 2TM, 2WG.. And not to forget the Cubans & Mex who gave me a pain in the neck this season, refusing to reply. Rec'd a CBA verie card, postmarked Halifax N.S. I've notice this past season more stations are refusing to answer reports. At time of writing I have some 34 reports out to U.S. stations, these are for duplicate veries, have verified over 300 stations the past winter for duplicates (A Joe Becker style)

The total for the season is 218 reports sent out and 189 veries received with 18- 200 milers. The total over all is 206 veries with 22- 200 milers. The one I think is best is KHBC 250 watts in Hilo Hawaii and it took a 23 tube Scott to bring it in. I do not enter any in my log unless the verie is in my file so my log now is only 206 stations. The old log I threw away and started this one counting only the verified stations. Well so long for now aa heres hoping that the next DX season rolls around soon and hope to have as much pleasure from the NRC as I have had this past DX season and thanks a lot for inducing me to join.
