MARSHALL BLANCHARD-BROOKFIELD ILL. I am just getting well. I dont know what I had but I sure was sick. The only DXing I have done is on the two specials on the 2nd and 3rd. WTCM had a nice program. I hope they get my "boxtop". WCBT was very badly QRM'd here by WLVA and WFTC. Latest veries are from KFYZ-XEYV-XEYOY. Reports have gone out to WTCM--WCBT--CMCY-KOCA, a back report to XEWE. KFYZ sends a gold on black verie stamp. Altogether I have 39 reports in the mail, 21 to foreign countries. I have been hearing a Spick on 825, Could anyone help me on them? Boy was I surprised to look at the list of specials in this weeks bulletin. There were almost twice as many as in the previous list. Another thing I would like some help on is, on the quiet mornings of some of these stations that stay on all night, such as WITH-WJW. (WITH off every Tuesday at 3AM-1230) (WJW on 1240 is off every Monday morning at about 12 or 1AM) (WBAL-1340 off every 2nd Wednesday morning at 2 or 3 AM) (1490 channel never clear) (1450 channel not clear either except when they sign off for our specials) Hope that you are feeling OK Marshall and that your DXing will get another workout.

NORM MAGUIRE-ALBUQUERQUE, N.MEX. Well I have been rather busy the last 2 weeks so no reports. Nothing has been doing along the verification line. Veries in since last report are, WAOV-CFCN-KWON-WNAB-WSTV from back in Conn at Xmas. KFDA-KGHL and KFUN from here. Got some fine replies in this group. WAOV was a fine personal letter from c,op. CFCN was a long ~~XXXXXXXX~~ wanted station from Alberta. Have hrd it from here and from back there, but never bothered to write. KWON on 2nd special said that mine was their 1st report from Conn since they went on the air. KFUN special was of course well received here, its only a stone's throw from here-130 miles. The manager wrote me a very nice note. Am sorry to hear that more of you didnt hear the fine program they put on for us. WNAB brings me to a point where there is only 1 station in Conn not verified. Well I'll be shooting for it on the 7th, WSRR imagine that. KFDA and KGFL both came back, only after sending prepared cards. KGHL said they have no cards. See where Fred Van is having trouble with KWTO. Me too with 2 rpts to them. Fred could you get me the signer of WHB? Need them badly and is only K.C. station missing. Been awfully hard to pull veries thru. Isnt moorside Edge on 668kc? Or how they would? If so who is holding down that freq? (CONT ON PG 4)

NORM MAGUIRE cont I want some help on when WSNY tests. Do they ever? As to 24 hour stations operating out this way on the low powered channels KGFI is on 1230 kcs and KSAN on 1450 kcs all night. In spite of KGFI and WITH plus some other station I still managed to get a fair amount of data on WCBT this morning. (Norm WITH was off but WFTC and WLVA were on) Please tell Kermit that I haven't been able to hear any Mexican on 600 kc as KROD is right close to hear and they control that channel, only 300 miles.

GEORGE LUTH-KERRVILLE TEXAS New catches in past week-KROS-WTCM-KWLK-KTTS Freq relogs WRDw on 1430, WCBT. 2/2 WCBT program a glorious mess here, with channel sounded about like early evening, but did get one good call. KGFI and Hilo in it, of course and at least two ~~xxxxxx~~ others undetermined. WITH seldom hrd here. WTCM very good though and I sent report even though I don't verify generally. KTTS on about an hour 2/4 with music and osc tests. KHM0-1340 tests 3:30-4 EWT 1st Wed monthly. You say WSBT on 980, when did they leave 960? (That is what Lefty had in his report-Ray) (Its probably just a slight error) Morrison reports CMZ on 1420, dope I had months ago put CMK there from 740. Does anyone know where CMK is now? I haven't hrd them any where for a couple years, or was my dope screwy. Also understand KFAP has application only for 660, not yet granted by FCC up to a few weeks ago. Geary does as well in Penn as I can here in Texas on 600. We agree on Torreon, I have made it sound like XEBM and XEDN while he says XEDM, so we're probably both getting warm. A little more light on 1600 channel, the Mex I wrote about last week is definitely XEJ (B-T or similar sound) location in dark yet. Have heard in program data, not in call, Cuadajajara once and Guanajuato several times so figure it is around there. Wonder if XEJB could have moved from 1010. I hear a Cuban on 1600 also but haven't figured him out either. Have hrd both s-off, 10:30 to 11 EWT and that didn't help.

STAN MORSS-BROADFORD MASS. Here is the time schedules of the Boston stations for week-days. WNAC-6AM-2AM; WBZ-6AM-1AM; WEEI-5:30AM-1:05AM; WHDH 6:30AM-1AM; WMEX-8AM-12MDT; WCOP-6:30AM-12MDT; WORL-6:30AM-5:30PM; and WHEB-8:15AM-6:45PM; WHLC-7AM-8PM. Radio Lyons on with Radio Journal of France at 2:30AM on 640 kcs about R7. Radio Toulouse on at 2:30 AM talking about Andre Collet; WTCM about R7 on its NRC Special. Who is the French speaking station on about 1385kcs? According to "Broadcasting" WJWC has asked the FCC to resign its license as is to discontinue operation in a few days. W8XO has been authorized to use 750,000 watts experimentally. Carr Collins has offered XEAW to Baylor University if there (Baylor) C.P. for a station is granted. He is going to move the station to Corpus Christi and will operate it for Baylor for 25 years. The C.P. is for 1010 with 50KW.

Reports to KEVE-WAIM-CHEX (I have the worst luck with specials verifying) WRRF-WLOG-WIBU-WJLD-KICD-WCBT-WFTC-WLVA-KPHO-WTCM-WSRR-WRDO-WABY-WMOB-WRLC. Veries in from WBTH-WLAG-WLVA letters and fb card from KICD. Sent follow up to WALL 2 weeks ago and still no verie. ~~Like~~ I'm beginning to hate them-Hi. WJLD hrd 1/27 from 4-5 with test. WLOG on 1/25 at 2:15-2:55 sponsoring some sort of DX contest and saying a DXer in woline Ill is leader in it. WCBT hrd fair on DX. WTCM came in beautifully as did WSRR-both very neat DX. KPHO hrd on 2/3 3-3:15 with reg check, R7 behind WITH. WABY on 2/8 from 3-3:15 R9, WRDO same date 3:15-3:30 only R5 and W8XO messing em up R6-figure that one out. WMOB on 2/8 3:30-3:40; WRLC 2/8 3:45-4 but saying they'd be on at a different time next month due to time change. KICD hrd pleading for reports on 2/2 from 2:40-2:55. Boy I am praying for cold weather on those Canadians. CJIC wrote back saying they would be only too glad to go on for us after the war, but gave no reason why they couldn't go on now. Tnks to you fellows for helping me on the call letter meanings. I got swell response. (I'll drop WALL a line-Ray)

JOHN KALMBACH JR-WILLIAMSVILLE N.Y. Have been doing a lot of DXing since Gas restriction, sent reports to WCAE-WRBL-WESX-WJEJ-WHAI-WNOX-WTCM-WTCM WSRR. Veries came in from WCAE a card, WJEJ swell letter, WHAI and WRBL wrote back and said I must have had the wrong station as they do not carry Luden's cough drop ads. I hrd WESX-WHAI-WJEJ-WRBL between 9-11 PM on Sun Jan 31st. WEVD still havent answered. Enjoyed the programs from WTCM-WSRR very much. Added a Globe and map of the US to my Radio Den.

JOE ENZ-BROOKLYN, N.Y. Only veries in of late, making total 558 are KVFD-WOOD-CHEX. DX not so good the past few week ends, on 2/1 WAOV & WLAP testing, WAOV 2-2:30 AM EWT. Still hear station on 540 kcs, Sun & Mon AMs, must be a Mexican playing marimba music???. Hrd station on 1395 kcs 2/2, man rapidly talking then sounded like a gong, could this be Lyons, 2:30AM? (Yes Joe that was Lyons-Hay) On 2/7 WSRH fb for the club, however have them verified but will send a card thanking them. CHPS sure send a fb letter, its great how those Canadian stations cooperate. On 2/8 DX fine, tried for KYA but Mexican was on; KVFD-R9 again at 2:35 reg check; WMAS 1-1:15 check; WILM-2:15 check. Reports to 2/3 WTCM on NRC special 3-4:37 a swell program; 2/4 WSAP testing equipt 2:32-3:18 here is one to figure out, announced as 1490 kcs but 2:30-2:53 on 1400 kcs and 2:58-3:18 on 1440 Q5 R9 but they still announced 1490 kc. and ~~KXXX~~ no QRM; to WWSW-WJBK from WSAP, not possible for a harmonic or skip on the band, how come? 2/7 WSRR DX special 4-6:02 AM a peach of a show, plenty of plugs for the NRC, I liked the part, "The National Radio Club Is On The Air" Q4 R9; 2/7 KWTO on 560 for daytime reception 9:58-10:16AM; 2/9 KGKL-1400 2nd Tues 4:30-4:45 Q3-4 R7. 2/9 WORK-1350 6:30-6:46 Q4 R9 been after this one for 7 years. Tuesdays on 1230kc 3-3:30AM KHBC now QRMd by KGFJ, hard to log; KHBC s-off at 3:46AM EWT. TO JULLY SULLIVAN-Best Wyoming station to log is RPOW-1230 4th Wed 4-4:15, signer A.J. Meyer; MAINE station WRDO-1400 kc 3:15-3:30 2nd Mon, signer Harold Densinore; IDAHO-KID-1350 kc used to test 2nd Sun 3-3:30AM EWT; NEVADA KOH-630 hard to log, signs off at 3AM EWT bad QRM now. NEW HAMPSHIRE-WLNH -1340 used to test 2nd Mon 3:50-4:05; ARIZONA-KWJB-1240 on 2nd Fri from 3:55-4:10. STANWOOD MORSS-BRADFORD MASS Heard WMFJ on with test 2/9 at 3:20 AM and was R5-6. The Rev Bob Shuler former owner of KGBF in Los Angeles has been forced off the air again for speaking too freely, he has recently been on KPAS in Pasadena. This from "Broadcast"

Pvt Ed Wyman-809 T.S.S. (Sp)-Barracks 412-Sioux Falls, So Dakota Note my new QRA. Its really cold here and I dont mean maybe. Here are a few items left over from Miami Beach. WQAM's slogan is "The Voice of Tropical America"; WFTL's is "The Orange Blossom Station". I still can not find or hear a Cuban on 640 kc. I did get Hok at about 2PM a couple days.
