(OK Lefty talking with Kenny he said they should as KWON counted both times) 2/27 Tried again for KFUN-no go. 2/28 Swell morning for western stations, reported KFWB-KPRO-CFJC. WATN was on with a test-off at 2:07. 910 kcs was really busy as at 4 when CFJC was to start, WRNL was testing, coming in poorly about R5. They kept playing the same transcription of an Army Air Corps drama. Finally they signed off at about 4:35 or so. I am usually up at that hour but decided to do some DXing around sign on time and the only thing that softened the disappointment was the fact that I added five new stations to my log. In this order.. WGBG at 6:15; WMAM at 7:50 after all these years of trying for them .. WSBA at 8; KGNF at 8:15 and WSON at 9AM. Needless to state, reports are out to all. I dont seem to be having difficulty getting reports past the censor. Maybe the fun will begin when the veries try to come in.

JACK WILLARD-DENVER COLO It has been over a year since I have been home and had a chance to read the bulletins. They certainly have piled up in my absance, but I am going to make up for lost time now. My draft board has classified me 1*A and the signal corps seems to want my Hallicrafters SX-24 so until were both drafted I am going to get in a few good licks in the DX direction. I hope to have something good to report in a couple of weeks. While I was traveling around for western Electric Co. I used to hear plenty but I never could find time to write out the reports. I have the time now but only my draft board knows how much. (Well Jack it seems good to hear from you and it is hoped that you will be able to get in a lot of DXing before you are called. Dont forget that when you do go let us know your address as soon as you have one.-Ray)

DON WATTENBARGER-MILL VALLEY CALIF I have been meaning to join the NRC for a long time but never got to it, so I am not delaying any longer. My receiver is a SKY CHIEF 7 tubes with a 175 ft antenna. I have veries from about 50 bcb and about 20 from SW stations, some of my best catches on the BCB are 2YA-WBAL-CMCY- and WSUN. So you see I still have a long way to go. Some of my catches on Sw are VUD-2 ZRH-MTCY and VLR-CXALO-TGWA-OAX4C and more S As. I dont see how some fellows get London on BCB. Ivor Sutherland and I have been wondering about something? It is - are the reports still getting through to foreign countries? (Yes Don some are and some are not, it seems just depending on the censor who opens your report. It seems that reports to Canada and Mexico are going thru and coming back OK, but to the other countries they get thru now and then and many times they are returned.) Last night hrd WBAL with a Q3 R 4-5, most of the east coast stations pound in here R 8-9 in the early mornings. Log now stands 830 BCB, this covers 10 years of DXing off and on. Also congrats to the CPC for the fb DX from CFJC, came thru R 8-9 here at 4:48. Been trying for them for 3 years. Could not land KBPS or KwKw but will try again next time. Hrd KRE this AM 2/28 before 3AM EWT also WSTV freq ck on 1380 at 4:05, they test on 30th of every month but were on the 28th of Feb. Am hoping for a break in the weather on 3/2 for those Canadians, havent logged any of them as yet. On 2/28 XEJP-1150; XEMX-1380; XEMC-1590 all R8-9 KRE R6. Had 2 years of Spanish in high school so Spicks are friends of mine. Veries in from WCBI-WBTH and reports out to WSOY-CHPS-KICD-KHBC-WJPF-WJOB-KBIZ-WTSP-WCED-CFJC. Could not land CJFX, (they were not on-if you hrd CKNB this AM 3/4 they explained why-Ray) Is any one logging S As or Central Americans? If so when and where please. Well the weather man was good to me on the Canadian specials, all received R9 plus even CHAD although QMed by WEXL but got enough from 3:52-3:59. Other 2 were R 9 plus Q5 all the time. Very fine programs and many thanks to Al Bartholomew for these. CHLT was also on most of the AM for a DX for all DXers in US and Canada and asked for a lot of reports. R9 thru WJW. KWON on this AM at 2:35 with test, dont know if it was their regular one or not. WCED aslo at 2:45 to 3 with reg ck. WOOD granted full time operation with facilities of WASH..WWNY is a new CBS affiliate... WBYN has filed application to move main studios to New York..WORK has been granted CP for new xmitter..KSWO has applied for unlimited time...WBNY has asked for unlimited time on 680 kcs with 250 watts..WSAP is the only FCC license to be issued since Pearl Harbor and the station went on the air Feb 9th with a dailoy sked of 6AM-2AM..the WALB case before the FCC is reported to have reached "white heat" on several occasions..WJWC officially went off the air at 12:30 AM Sunday morning Feb 7th having notified the FCC of its intnetion to surrender its license on January 28th. War conditions making it difficult to obtain materials ot overcome insufficient coverage resulting in operation losses were given as reason for closing WJWC..Hammond Calumet Broadcasting Corp., however, will remain alive and may resume activities after the war..all the WJWC equipment including their 5Kw W-E xmitter and 5 directional towers have been offered for sale. (Thanks a lot Stuart and I believe that our members will appreciate this information to help keep their logs in order-Ray)

GENE FRANCIS-DETROIT MICH For the past year I had supposed that the only new stations I would be able to add to my log would be those that put on specials or conducted tests. And with 27 new stations logged in January, I didn't expect more than a dozen at the most in February. I under~~xxxx~~ estimated my location and my receiver. I can easily add to my list of top radio-thrills the morning of February 4th when my first SA, HJCU came pounding in, only to be followed 4 hours later by my first Zedder, 1YA. Both were naturally reported and since neither report was returned by the censor, I suppose they got through. Maybe the fun will begin when the veries try to pass the censors into the States. Except WJAG (which I thought I had, but was mistaken) the only "W's" left are on the graveyard channels. Here's what I got in February. WSAP-WRRF-WGCB-WAYS-WHB-WSBA-WSOJ-WMAM-KFBC-KFEL-KFSG-KGDE-KLEB (E Griebel's station, heard when he heard it)-KMTR-KPOW-KSJB-KSOO-KTFI (heard for 3 minutes each morning after WHBF signs off at 1:00AM)-KTSA-KTTS-KWAL-KWAT-KWKW-KYUM. And in Canada and other nations; CFQC-CHAB-CJKL-CJOR-CJVI-CKCK-CMJK-CMKU-XEO-XEJP-XEON-XETU-XEHL-XEMX-XEGM-XELZ-HJCC-London National and Lyons National on 648. Whispering on 680 one exceptionally good Monday around 5AM. most likely Invercargill, a very faint signal on 790 probably Dunedin, and jumbled whisperings on 720 should have been Christchurch and Goldie fields Regional. Incidentally Er Eric Bristow's sermon station on 1240 was KWIL broadcasting its weekly Old Fashioned Revival Hour.

MARSHALL BLANCHARD-BROOKFIELD ILL Latest veries received, that is in the past week are cards from; -KGO-KFBK-WSKB-KPHO-KBIZ and letters from WISE₂ CJVI-WDAY-KAST. Reports have gone out to KFJX on Lefty's tip, WGIL-WLOF-WFNC-WCED-WWSR-CKMO-CFJC. Hrd a station behind KLX playing Brazil, no announcements were heard. As I have a few other tunes I sent to CJFC. All I do now is hope. To LEFTY COOPER-Report to XEOY was sent to XEOY-mexico City. Address on verie is Paseo de la Reforma-66-Mexico City. In case you care to phone 18-14-40-Y. Tnx for tip on KFXJ, have been looking for them Tomorrow I will be trying for CKRN-CHAD-CKVD, conditions look favorable here so far. 2/24 I hrd a station leaving the air in English, said he'd return at 8AM and then signed with S S Banner. Could this have been WPAB? Maybe Eric Bristow could tell me. (No Marchall they are Post Paid-Ray)

That was a honey of a location, several of the Australian stations were almost daily visitors via my radio there. In fact I used to get 2YA even in the Summer time. In 1934 I moved back to Detroit and practically gave up DXing as I was working long hours in a Tool & Die shop. I have been in Moline since Sept 1939, working at the Rock Island Arsenal. I started DXing again this last fall and its surprising how many stations I need of the ones on the air now. Back in 1934 I had nearly all of the US stations verified needing I believe only 2% to complete the job. Now it is almost like starting over. I am verifying a lot of the stations over from here though that I had verified back in Michigan. I guess my biggest thrill came when Milt Christa and I journeyed over to CKLW in Windsor, Ontario to take part in the DX program put on by the Mutual Network for the Newark News Radio Club. I had a swell time there but when I was introduced over the air I got a nice case of Mike Fright. After a few words though that disappeared and I got along all right. I'll never forget the workout the engineer got that morning. He showed us around the studios and transmitter and it seemed every time we got quite a ways from the control room, Mutual would pause for station identification. He would then dash for the control room, usually thru two or three doors. For awhile after that every time I heard a door slam I thought of that engineer dashing for the control room and all out of breath trying to say CKLW in Windsor. When I arrived home my wife wanted to know what we did to the announcer to keep him out of breath all morning.
