One on 1474 was plenty loud several AMs around 1:10 AM. One showing on 804 after CKLW leaves the air. Didnt hear that one last winter. CKCK has been on top from 1:15-1:30 s/off past several mornings. WKVM testing Tuesdays from 3-4 for RCA. KOOS in back of the 1230 mess and copied easily KRKO s/off at 3:30 with KRE still on and coming thru well. Thought I had Stones 2PK at first but it was KRE. Sorry Lefty, the Cuban on 660 QRMing WEAFF is CMBC Radio Progreso and besides CMZ-1 changed call well over a year ago. Dont they get the news down there in Brooklyn? Cubans seem to have made numerous changes and I would suggest listening for exact call letters rather than taking any of them for granted. CMQ network station splitting on 685 kcs just 5 kc from CMQ.
